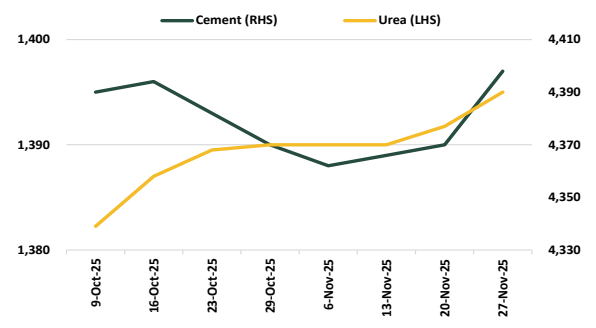

Egypt, Pakistan take big step forward: (Economy: Positive)

Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar said on Sunday that Pakistan will share a list of 250 leading Pakistani business houses with Egypt to boost bilateral commercial engagement. Speaking at a joint press conference alongside Egyptian Foreign Minister Dr Badr Ahmed Mohamed Abdelatty, Dar said both sides held "very focused" discussions on strengthening business-to-business cooperation. At present, the volume of trade between Pakistan and Egypt stands at approximately \$300 million, he said.

OPEC+ holds oil output steady, agrees capacity mechanism: (Economy: Positive)

OPEC+ agreed to leave oil output levels unchanged for the first quarter of 2026 at its meetings on Sunday as the group slows down its push to regain market share amid fears of a looming supply glut. The meeting of OPEC+, which pumps half of the world's oil, comes during a fresh US effort to broker a peace deal between Russia and Ukraine, which could add to oil supply if sanctions on Russia are eased.

Aurangzeb hints at reducing taxes: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Finance Minister Mohammad Aurangzeb cautioned that the government will keep a close eye on balance of payment and current account to ensure sustainability in growth, but ready to reduce taxes on formal sectors with the help of Tax Policy Office fully engaged to facilitate formal sector where ever fiscal space is available. Addressing a press conference on Sunday, Aurangzeb said that the structural reform must be done at par with the institutional reforms. He said Large Scale Manufacturing has witnessed an increase of 4.2 percent during first four months of July-October (205-26), reflecting increased local activity in terms of domestic economy and growth.

Pakistan, Iran sign \$4m Agri-food deals: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistani and Iranian companies signed three agreements worth over \$4 million at Food AG 2025 in Karachi, marking the largest commercial outcome between the two countries at the trade fair. The agreements span the sesame seed, rice, and meat sectors. Multiple Pakistani companies have been invited to Iran to finalize commercial contracts following negotiations at the exhibition. The delegation expressed gratitude to the Trade Development Authority of Pakistan for organizing Food AG 2025.

FM forms Capital Market Council, orders review of taxation framework: (Economy: Positive) (PSX: Positive)

Pakistan has set up a Capital Market Development Council (CMDC) to steer wide-ranging reforms across the country's financial markets, as Finance Minister Senator Muhammad Aurangzeb directed regulators and government bodies to review capital market taxation, issuer-side incentives, and frameworks for encouraging listings. Participants reviewed the Terms of Reference and discussed a structured strategy aimed at broadening market participation, deepening liquidity, improving access to finance, and encouraging both debt and equity capital raising. A significant portion of the meeting focused on taxation, identified as a major factor affecting market competitiveness.

Govt slashes petrol by Rs2, diesel Rs4.79: (Economy: Positive) (OMCs: Neutral to Negative)

The federal government on Sunday reduced the prices of petrol and high-speed diesel (HSD) by Rs2 and Rs4.79 per litre, respectively, for the fortnight ending December 15, due to a minor fluctuation in the international market. According to the announcement, the ex-depot price of HSD has been reduced by Rs4.79 per litre (1.68pc) to Rs279.65 per litre for the current fortnight from the previous rate of Rs284.44.

Oil industry awaits decision on Sindh cess: (Economy: Neutral)

The oil industry is now looking towards the apex court for withdrawal of the Sindh Infrastructure Development Cess, which may lead to the collapse of oil companies and refineries. The meeting concluded with the understanding that the AAGP, in consultation with the PSO legal counsel and Ogra, would make all efforts to fix the court case in the upcoming week for resolution of the matter. Earlier, oil cargoes had been stuck at Karachi Port due to a tussle between the oil industry and the Sindh government over the infrastructure cess. However, oil crisis is still looming if the issue is not resolved as Sindh seeks to recover Rs180 billion in infrastructure cess from the industry.

Nov collection seen reaching Rs900bn against Rs995bn target: (Economy: Neutral)

The tax collection of the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) will reach around Rs 900 billion during November 2025 against the assigned target of Rs995 billion, reflecting a shortfall of Rs95 billion. The achievement of the monthly target is 90 percent during November 2025.

Coal power plants repatriate \$135m in profits: (Economy: Negative)

The coal-based power plants repatriated \$135 million in profits during the month of October, one of the highest outflows of profits by coal-fired power plants in recent years. During the first four months of the current fiscal year, power generation from imported coal fell 54 per cent, while generation from local coal increased by five per cent.

Inflation to remain at 5-6pc in November: (Economy: Neutral)

The Ministry of Finance has projected that inflation is expected to remain in the range of 5.0 per cent to 6.0 per cent in November due to pressures on food prices and agricultural output. CPI inflation recorded 6.2 per cent YoY in October 2025, compared with 5.6 per cent in the previous month and 7.2 per cent in October 2024. On an MoM basis, it increased by 1.8 per cent, compared with 2.0 per cent in the previous month and 1.2 per cent in October 2024.
