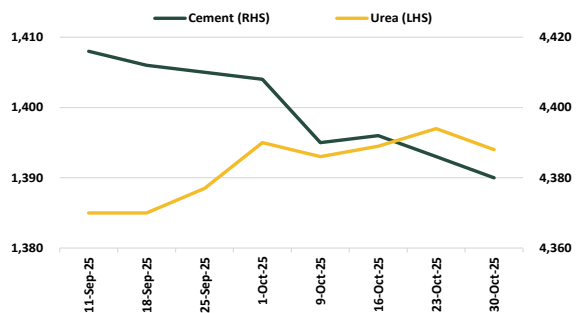

Pakistan rejects Kabul's border firing claims, urges respect for ceasefire: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan on Thursday rejected Afghan allegations that its forces initiated firing along the Chaman-Spin Boldak border crossing, urging Kabul to uphold the existing ceasefire and maintain calm amid ongoing bilateral talks in Istanbul. "We strongly reject claims circulated by the Afghan side regarding today's incident at the Pak-Afghan border at Chaman," the Ministry of Information said. According to the ministry, "Firing was initiated from the Afghan side, to which our security forces responded immediately in a measured and responsible manner." It added that the situation was "brought under control due to responsible action by Pakistani forces and the ceasefire remains intact."

27th Amendment: PPP committee rejects proposed amendments to NFC Award: (Economy: Neutral)

The Pakistan Peoples Party's (PPP) Central Executive Committee (CEC) late on Thursday night firmly rejected proposed changes to the National Finance Commission (NFC) award formula. Addressing the presser, Bilawal said that the PPP's CEC meeting gave its nod to the proposed amendment to Article 243 of the Constitution. He maintained that his party rejected rest of all proposed amendments to the Constitution. The PPP chairman said the final decision on the proposed constitutional court would be made at the CEC meeting scheduled after Friday prayers.

Aurangzeb lauds 34pc growth in pharma exports: (Economy: Positive, Pharma: Positive)

Minister for Finance and Revenue, Senator Muhammad Aurangzeb has lauded the pharma sector's 34 percent export growth. The meeting focused on the industry's export performance, the government's reform initiatives, and the future roadmap for making Pakistan a major player in the global pharmaceutical market. The delegation said the Pakistan Pharmaceutical Manufacturers' Association (PPMA) is aiming for USD 10 billion exports. They discussed the establishment of PharmEx Pakistan, a dedicated pharmaceutical export platform to plan and execute strategies for achieving USD 3 billion in pharmaceutical exports within the next three years, and USD 10 billion over the subsequent five years.

SBP reserves rise by \$31 million to \$14.5bn: (Economy: Positive)

The State Bank of Pakistan's (SBP) foreign exchange reserves increased by \$31 million to \$14.50 billion during the week ended October 31, 2025, according to data released by the central bank on Thursday. The SBP said total liquid foreign reserves held by the country stood at \$19.66 billion as of October 31. Of this, the central bank held \$14.50 billion, while net reserves held by commercial banks amounted to \$5.16 billion.

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Power & gas supply: Textile body seeks single tariff based on 'WACOG': (Economy: Neutral)

The Pakistan Textile Council (PTC) has sought a single tariff based on WACOG (Weighted Average Cost of Gas), doing away with the cross-subsidy, and the reclassification of the combined heat power plants. In a letter to Advisor to the Prime Minister, Dr. Tauqir Hussain Shah has submitted that the export-oriented industries are facing severe challenges due to the growing inefficiencies and policy inconsistencies in the energy sector. The uncoordinated expansion of power plants and solar generation has disrupted grid stability, while the current mechanism for selling excess capacity remains ineffective and urgently requires reassessment.

Germany's commitment includes both financial and technical assistance, focusing on key areas such as climate and energy (just transition), sustainable economic development and vocational training, and social protection. The next round of Pakistan-Germany development cooperation negotiations will be held in Berlin in 2027.

TRG Pakistan profit jumps nearly threefold to Rs6.9bn in Jul-Sep 2025: (Economy: Positive, TRG: Positive)

TRG Pakistan, a non-banking finance company, has reported nearly threefold increase in its profit-after-tax (PAT) in the quarter ended September 30, 2025, in the wake of a significant growth in the share of profit driven from its associate firm The Resource Group International Limited (TRGIL). TRG Pakistan net profit jumped to Rs6.9 billion in July-September 2025, against Rs2.4 billion recorded in the same period last year, according to the company's detailed financial accounts for the said quarter. The net profit translated into earnings per share (EPS) at Rs12.59 for the quarter ended September 30, compared to Rs4.41 EPS in the same period last year.
