Hang Seng	26,134.60	-1.23%	Nepra cuts power tariff by 62 paise: (Economy: Neutral to Positive) The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (Nepra) has reduced the national average uniform electricity tariff by 62 paise per unit for the next six months, effective January 1. The regulator has determined separate consumer-end tariffs for each distribution company (ex-Wapda Discos) in view of their differing revenue requirements and permitted levels of transmission and distribution (T&D) losses. 03-Month	10.53%	-0.02%	Govt decides to fully deregulate sugar sector: (Economy: Neutral to Positive) In a significant policy shift, the government, in collaboration with the farming community and sugar industry representatives, has decided to fully deregulate the sugar sector, marking a key step in implementing structural reforms recommended by the International Monetary Fund (IMF). The deregulation move will hand control of the sugar industry over to market forces, ending decades of state intervention. The decision follows the earlier deregulation of the wheat sector, with sugar now set to follow suit. They will also have the liberty to sell their sugarcane to any sugar mill or use it to produce jaggery, free from government control. As part of the deregulation, the government has also pledged to eliminate subsidies on sugar exports and remove the current export quotas on sugar mills. https://epaper.brecorder.com/2026/01/08/1-page/1083001-news.html

PKR/USD	280.06	0.00%	FCC questions gap between super tax collection, spending on IDPs: (Economy: Positive) Justice Syed Hassan Azhar Rizvi, a member of the three-judge Federal Constitutional Court (FCC), on Tuesday regretted that while Rs144 billion was collected under the super tax between 2015 and 2020, only Rs37bn was spent on the rehabilitation of internally displaced persons, observing that the disparity frustrated the very purpose of imposing the levy under Section 4B of the Income Tax Ordinance (ITO). Pakistan inaugurates first Hong Kong convention-certified ship recycling yard: (Economy: Positive)

Minister for Maritime Affairs Muhammad Junaid Anwar Chaudhry on Wednesday inaugurated Pakistan's first ship recycling facility certified under the Hong Kong International Convention (HKC), calling it a historic step towards safer and more environmentally responsible practices in a sector long criticised for hazardous working conditions.

T-bill yields drop as traders bet on another rate cut: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Yields on market Treasury bills moved lower on Wednesday, as investors expected another rate cut at the central bank's monetary policy meeting this month. The one-month T-bill yield dropped 29 basis points (bps) to 10.2 percent, while the three-month paper yield was down 34bps to 10.1501 per cent, the auction result published by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) showed. The six-month T-bill yield was down by 32bps to 10.158 per cent. The yield on the 12-month note fell 33bps to 10.159 per cent.

Gas circular debt swells to Rs3.2tr: (Economy: Negative)

Pakistan's gas circular debt has surged to Rs3,200 billion, up from Rs2,600 billion, largely due to a sharp increase in Late Payment Surcharge (LPS), which now stands at Rs1,450 billion, officials said. Of the remaining Rs1,750 billion, around Rs210 billion has accumulated due to income tax and GST, while the actual stock of circular debt is estimated at Rs15 billion. The government plans to waive off the LPS, arguing that gas suppliers — exploration and production (E&P) companies — and buyers — Sui gas companies, are government-owned entities and did not borrow from banks to incur these charges. However, Pakistan State Oil (PSO) will be required to pay its LPS, as it borrowed from banks to meet its LPS obligations. The government also intends to eliminate Rs210 billion in income tax and GST liabilities.

PSO rejects Fotco's proposed flow-rate penalties on oil cargoes: (Economy: Neutral) (PSO: Neutral)

Pakistan State Oil (PSO) has opposed the unilateral imposition of flow-rate penalties by Fauji Terminal and Distribution Company Limited (FOTCO) on the import and export of oil cargoes, declaring that it will not accept the proposed charges. "In a situation where OMCs are already incurring heavy demurrage due to port constraints and Fotco's inefficiencies, penalising OMCs and vessels for not achieving an average flow rate of 2,500 tonnes per hour is unjustifiable and commercially unsustainable," PSO said. "Imposing a penalty thereafter appears less like a performance deterrent and more like an attempt to create a permanent additional revenue stream," PSO said.
