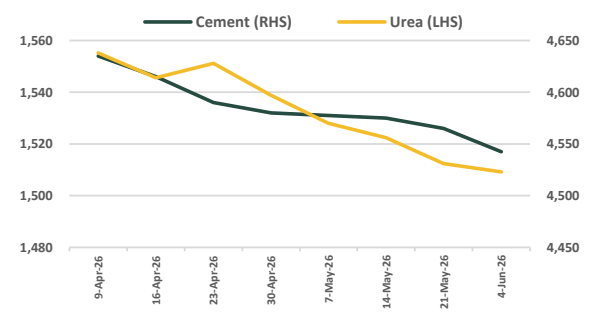

**US slaps fresh sanctions as rockets, drones fly in Hormuz:** (Economy: Neutral to Negative)  
Tensions remained high in the Strait of Hormuz, as Iran claimed to have fired 'warning shots' at US vessels, while Washington denied the claim, and responded with a fresh set of sanctions targeting Iranian assets and vessels. According to the Tasnim news agency, the Iranian navy fired missiles attack drones, forcing two US destroyers to leave the Sea of Oman.

**OPEC+ approves fourth oil output quota hike since Hormuz closure:** (Economy: Neutral)  
OPEC+ agreed on Sunday a fourth increase in its oil output targets in as many months, even though the US war with Iran is still preventing several of the group's members from pumping more. The war has cut oil flows via the Strait of Hormuz, creating the world's biggest-ever supply crisis as key OPEC+ members including Saudi Arabia have been unable to supply customers in full since the end of February.

**BUDGET 2026-27: ECC expands bureaucrats' stipend, okays Rs40bn grants:** (Economy: Neutral to Negative)  
Less than a week before the next budget, the Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) of the cabinet on Friday approved more than Rs40 billion in supplementary grants and a Rs100bn sovereign-guarantee-backed financing facility for the Pakistan State Oil (PSO), which is facing over Rs900bn in receivables from other state-owned enterprises, raising concerns about smooth oil supplies.

**Proposed tax cuts await IMF nod ahead of budget:** (Economy: Neutral to Negative)  
Pakistan's economic managers are awaiting the International Monetary Fund's approval for a package of proposed tax relief measures and fresh revenue-raising initiatives ahead of the 2026-27 federal budget. Talking to this reporter on Sunday night, top officials confirmed that it was becoming harder for the government to undertake number-crunching with the IMF to raise the tax collection target to Rs15,264 billion in the Fiscal Year 2026-27 after revising downward the tax collection target of Rs13,428 billion for the outgoing fiscal year ending on June 30, 2026.

**Pakistan buys priciest LNG shipment in years on Hormuz closure:** (Economy: Negative)  
State-owned Pakistan LNG Ltd bought a cargo for June 6-7 delivery from BP Plc via a tender that closed on Thursday, according to traders with knowledge of the matter. The South Asian country was forced to purchase it because a planned shipment from Qatar was cancelled due to heightened tensions around the strait, the traders said. Pakistan purchased its most expensive liquefied natural gas shipment in about four years, as the country grapples with an energy shortage due to the effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz, according to Bloomberg.

**Govt sets Rs290/\$ exchange rate:** (Economy: Neutral)  
The federal government has set the Rs290 to a dollar exchange rate for the new budget, which shows a nominal depreciation of 3.5% in the next fiscal year and indicates its comfort in meeting external debt repayment obligations. The exchange rate has been determined for the purpose of calculating disbursements and repayments of foreign loans and grants, as Pakistan officially follows a 'flexible exchange rate policy'.

**Govt borrows Rs3.5tr from banks in July-May:** (Economy: Neutral to Negative)  
More taxes and more borrowings from banks have been helping the government to continue with higher spending in FY26 against the IMF's suggestion for a cut in expenses. The latest data released by the State Bank showed that the federal government borrowed heavily from banks during the first 11 months of the current fiscal year. According to sources in the financial sector, the borrowing would be much higher during the closing days of FY26.

**SECP slaps Rs3.18m penalties on 'non-compliant' SOEs:** (Economy: Neutral)

The Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) has concluded enforcement proceedings against 36 State-Owned Enterprises (SOEs), imposing monetary penalties totaling Rs 3.18 million through 46 adjudication orders, while issuing warning orders in 12 cases.

**Pakistan, KSA finalise series of investment deals:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The agreements were signed during the two-day Saudi-Pakistan business engagement hosted by the Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC) and the Joint Business Council. Saudi Arabia and Pakistan on Friday agreed to deepen economic cooperation, with both sides finalising a series of investment agreements covering infrastructure, ports, motorways, real estate, and mineral development.

**Saudi Arabia plans crypto zone for Karachi:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan's government is currently working on regularising crypto trade, backed by US President Donald Trump. Pakistan has also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Saudi and local partners to explore the development of a maritime business district on prime waterfront land at Karachi Port. Saudi Arabia is set to establish a crypto and blockchain zone in Karachi along with studying the potential of other mega projects.

**Weekly inflation rises 14.75pc:** (Economy: Negative)

Short-term inflation, measured by the Sensitive Price Index (SPI), increased by 14.75 per cent year on year for the week ending June 4, mainly due to higher retail prices of perishable food items, according to official data released on Friday. The increase was largely driven by sharp gains in key items, including petrol (50.60pc), diesel (49.63pc), electricity charges (59.40pc), wheat flour (59.88pc), and liquefied petroleum gas (57.09pc).

**Govt jacks up petrol PL, reduces on HSD:** (Economy: Negative)

In its weekly review of petroleum prices effective from June 6, 2026, the government significantly increased petroleum levy (PL) on petrol, but at the same time reduced the levy on the high speed diesel (HSD). After the petroleum levy adjustment the government reduced petrol price by Rs4 per litre and kept HSD unchanged. Most of these substantial international price decline were adjusted by the government, which jacked up the PL on petrol by Rs24.74 per litre — surging from Rs91.34 to Rs116.08 per litre.

**Petrol price cut by Rs4, diesel rate unchanged:** (Economy: Neutral)

The government on Friday cut the price of petrol by Rs4 per litre while keeping the price of high-speed diesel unchanged with immediate effect for the week ending June 12, owing to changes in global prices during the last week. The ex-depot price of high-speed diesel (HSD) will remain fixed at Rs380.78 per litre for another week. The government made adjustments in taxes and other heads to maintain diesel prices, which otherwise appeared to be on the higher side.

**IT leads services export surge to \$8.27bn:** (Economy: Positive) (IT: Positive)

Pakistan's services exports grew by 17.68 per cent during the first 10 months of 2025-26, largely driven by higher earnings from the information technology sector, according to official data. Data compiled by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics showed that services exports increased to \$8.27bn in July-April FY26, from \$7.03bn a year ago.

**Gul Ahmed announces \$230m data centre:** (Economy: Positive) (GATM: Neutral to Positive)

Quantum Global Data Centre (QGDC), a venture of the Gul Ahmed Energy Group, announced plans on Thursday to develop Pakistan's largest Tier III data centre, which is expected to become operational in 2027 with an initial investment of \$230 million, Bloomberg reported. The project's investment could rise to \$600 million over the next three to four years.
