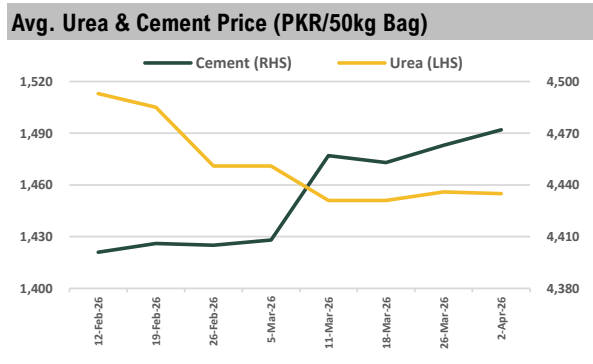

Islamabad takes centre stage, to host high-stakes US-Iran talks: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan is set to host in-person talks between the United States and Iran starting Friday, even as a fragile ceasefire between the two sides showed signs of strain following Israeli strikes in Lebanon and renewed military exchanges across the Gulf. The negotiations follow a two-week ceasefire announced late Tuesday — the 39th day of the war — after Pakistani mediation. The truce, which averted imminent US strikes, was based on a 10-point Iranian proposal accepted by Washington as a general framework for talks.

“Representatives from China, Afghanistan and Pakistan held a week of informal meetings in Urumqi, Xinjiang, from April 1 to 7,” Chinese foreign ministry spokeswoman Mao Ning said. The three delegations “engaged in frank and pragmatic discussions in a positive atmosphere,” she said at a regular news conference in Beijing.

Budget 2026-27: IMF to dispatch mission to Pakistan next month: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) plans to dispatch its mission to Pakistan next month to finalise the upcoming budget for 2026-27, as the Fund envisages the FBR’s tax collection target of Rs15.564 trillion for the next fiscal year. It is the wish of the Pakistani budget makers to fix the FBR’s target in the range of Rs15.232 trillion, knowing that the tax machinery will not be able to materialise the tax collection target of Rs13,979 billion for the ongoing fiscal year.

Oil plunges 15pc, stocks surge on ceasefire: (Economy: Positive)

“A wave of relief has hit financial markets after threats of a devastating escalation of the war were replaced by a temporary truce,” said Susannah Streeter, chief investment strategist, Wealth Club. The most widely traded oil contracts fell some 15 per cent to around \$95 a barrel, after a month of conflict that killed thousands and hammered the global economy. Brent crude futures were down \$13.57, or 12.42 per cent, at \$95.70 a barrel by 1:28pm ET (1728 GMT). WTI futures slid \$16.95, or 15.01pc, to \$96.

Kibor falls as lower oil prices ease inflation, rate hike worries: (Economy: Positive)

The Karachi Interbank Offered Rate (Kibor) declined across all tenors on Wednesday as a plunge in energy prices after a two-week ceasefire between the US and Iran eased concerns over inflation and interest rate hikes. According to data from the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP), the benchmark six-month Kibor fell by 18 basis points (bps) to 11.61 per cent. Similarly, the three-month Kibor dropped to 11.42 per cent, down from 11.68 per cent. The nine-month rate decreased to 11.96 per cent, falling from 12.13 per cent, while the one-year rate declined to 12 per cent, down from 12.16 per cent.

Fuel prices may drop sharply in Pakistan: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Prices of high-speed diesel (HSD) and petrol may fall significantly in the next fortnightly review following a drop in global crude oil prices, driven largely by the recent ceasefire between the US and Iran, industry sources said on Wednesday. Initial estimates suggest HSD prices could decline by up to Rs100 per litre, while petrol may become cheaper by around Rs60 per litre.

SBP repays \$1.43bn Eurobond: (Economy: Positive)

The central bank has successfully repaid a \$1.43 billion Eurobond that was maturing on April 8, it said on Wednesday. "The SBP has successfully executed the repayment of \$1.43 billion Pakistan's International Bond on April 7, 2026, which includes principal of \$1.3 billion, and the remaining amount is interest. The payment was made to the agent bank for onward distribution to bondholders on the maturity date of April 8, 2026," the State Bank of Pakistan said.

Central govt debt rises by 9.4% YoY in Feb 2026: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

The total debt of the central government went up by 9.37% YoY to Rs79.88 trillion in February 2026, compared to Rs73.04tr in February 2025, the data released by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) showed. Moreover, on a sequential basis, the central government debt increased by 0.7% MoM compared to Rs79.33tr in January 2026.

Remittances jump 17pc MoM to \$3.8bn in March: (Economy: Positive)

Remittances to Pakistan increased 16.5 per cent month-on-month (MoM) to \$3.8 billion in March, the central bank data showed on Wednesday, driven by a seasonal surge in these inflows during Eid, highlighting their resilience despite a war in the Middle East that lasted more than a month. However, money sent home by Pakistani workers employed abroad fell by 5.5 per cent year-on-year (YoY). Remittances rose 8.2 per cent to \$30.3 billion in the nine months of fiscal year 2026.

Wahdat Poultry Farm IPO gets SECP approval: (Economy: Positive) (PSX: Positive)

The Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) has approved the initial public offering (IPO) of Wahdat Poultry Farm, which signals continued investor confidence in the Pakistan Stock Exchange despite challenging economic and wartime conditions. The IPO will feature 50 million new shares and 3.1 million existing shares, offered through the book-building process, according to a press release issued. This marks the eighth IPO of the current fiscal year on the Pakistan Stock Exchange.
