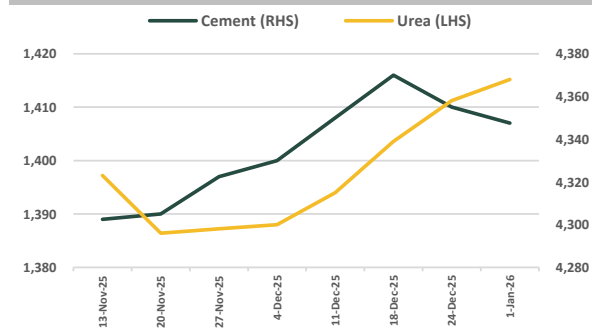

Trump backs bill to sanction China, India over Russian oil, US senator says: (Economy: Positive)

President Donald Trump has backed a bill to impose sanctions on countries that buy Russian oil, including China and India. Lindsey Graham, a senator for the US state of South Carolina, said that Trump had “greenlit” the bipartisan bill following a “very productive” meeting. Graham’s Sanctioning Russia Act, drafted with Democrat Richard Blumenthal, would give Trump the authority to impose a tariff of up to 500 percent on imports from countries doing business with Russia’s energy sector. “This bill will allow President Trump to punish those countries who buy cheap Russian oil, fueling Putin’s war machine,” referring to Russian President Vladimir Putin. “This bill would give President Trump tremendous leverage against countries like China, India and Brazil to incentivise them to stop buying the cheap Russian oil that provides the financing for Putin’s bloodbath against Ukraine.”

Govt wants to alter KE consumer-end tariff as per Nepra fixation: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The federal government has moved to enforce a uniform electricity tariff nationwide, including for K-Electric, by invoking its policy powers under the NEPRA Act following NEPRA’s January 7, 2026 decision to reduce the National Average Tariff by Rs0.62 per unit to Rs33.38/kWh. Although K-Electric’s average tariff had already been cut sharply by Rs7.6 per unit to Rs32.37/kWh, weakening its revenue outlook, the government has proposed aligning K-Electric and DISCO consumer-end tariffs through inter-DISCO rationalisation and targeted subsidies, without increasing overall revenue beyond NEPRA-approved requirements. The proposal, submitted to the federal cabinet and NEPRA, aims to ensure affordability and equity and, once approved, will lead to a uniform final tariff effective January 1, 2026, with NEPRA set to hold a public hearing on January 12, 2026.

Power sector: World Bank urges need for credible marginal price determination: (Economy: Neutral)

The World Bank has underscored the need for credible marginal price determination in Pakistan’s power sector, backed by transparent data, robust systems, and independent scrutiny, as the country grapples with mounting structural challenges driven by rapid solar adoption and persistent circular debt. The issue was discussed during a meeting between World Bank Country Director Bolormaa Amgaabazar and Minister for Power Sardar Awais Leghari, where both sides reviewed ongoing World Bank-supported projects and reform efforts in the power sector. Reaffirming the government’s commitment to reforms, the Minister highlighted key initiatives including DISCO privatisation, competitive procurement, and measures to strengthen investor confidence. However, he cautioned that the rapid expansion of off-grid and on-grid solar capacity—estimated at around 25,000 MW—has significantly increased fixed-cost pressure on the national grid.

Market liberalisation: Ogra to revisit gas pricing formula: (Economy: Neutral)

The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) has decided to review the existing gas pricing formula based on return on fixed assets keeping in view the current gas market liberalization. Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority has been tasked to restructure the two public gas utilities by doing away with the fixed asset-based return in the light of recommendations of consultancy firm KPMG. The regulator has started consultation with stakeholders to change the gas pricing formula. The regulator has scheduled a public hearing here on Friday to consider views of stakeholders.

Forex reserves rise by USD180m: (Economy: Positive)

According to official data released by the SBP on Thursday, the country's total liquid foreign reserves stood at USD 21.192 billion on January 2, 2026 compared with USD 21.012 billion a week earlier on December 26, 2025, reflecting an overall increase of about USD 180 million. During the week under review, the SBP's foreign exchange reserves increased by USD 141 million, reaching USD 16.056 billion up from USD 15.915 billion in the previous week. Net foreign reserves held by commercial banks also improved and surged by USD 39 million to reach USD 5.137 billion by end of last week compared to USD 5.097 billion a week earlier.

PTA rolls out 15-Year MVNO licensing framework: (Economy: Neutral)

The Pakistan Telecommunication Authority (PTA) has formally introduced a new regulatory framework for Mobile Virtual Network Operators (MVNOs) after receiving approval from the Federal Cabinet, a move aimed at strengthening competition and innovation in the telecom sector. The framework will allow MVNOs to launch mobile and advanced mobile services across the country under their own brand names by entering into commercial arrangements with existing Mobile Network Operators, APP reported. These operators will not be required to acquire spectrum. Licenses for MVNO services will be awarded for an initial term of 15 years, provided applicants meet the prescribed regulatory and compliance requirements.

Govt sets base prices for 5G spectrum auction in dollars: (Economy: Neutral)

The federal government has notified the base prices and spectrum volumes for the auction of next generation mobile services (5G), issuing a formal policy directive through the Ministry of Information Technology and Telecommunication after approval by the auction supervisory committee, chaired by Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb. The Pakistan Telecommunication Authority (PTA) will conduct the auction through a transparent and competitive process, covering six spectrum bands. The auction will include 15 MHz of paired spectrum in the 700 MHz band, 36 MHz of paired spectrum in the 1800 MHz band, 20 MHz of paired spectrum in the 2100 MHz band, 50 MHz of unpaired spectrum in the 2300 MHz band, 190 MHz of unpaired spectrum in the 2600 MHz band, and 280 MHz of unpaired spectrum in the 3500 MHz band.

EFERT secures increased gas allocation from Habib Rahi Limestone reservoir: (Economy: Neutral, EFERT: Positive)

Engro Fertilizers Limited (PSX: EFERT) is to receive an enhanced gas allocation of 105 MMscfd from the Habib Rahi Limestone (HRL) reservoir for its Base Plant, which the Government of Pakistan has approved. Previously supplied on an as-available basis, the gas volume has now been formally allocated to the company, the company's statement on PSX revealed today. The government has also approved that, in the event of natural depletion of the HRL gas reservoir, Mari Energies Limited may backfill the depleted volumes from its existing consumers, including Engro Fertilizers, using the Ghazi/Shawal reservoir.
