

**PM to unveil austerity plan today to cope with war fallout:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif is expected to unveil an austerity plan today (Monday) in view of the global fuel crisis, triggered by the US-Israel war on Iran, and the subsequent attacks on oil-producing Gulf states. Last week, the government increased the prices of petrol and high-speed diesel by Rs55 per litre, the highest-ever such hike, as the country felt the first direct economic impacts of the ongoing regional conflict.

**PM clears plan to abolish super tax:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif has given a go-ahead to seek the International Monetary Fund (IMF)'s consent for abolishing the super tax and reducing the income tax rate for salaried persons by 5%, in a move that provides some solace to overly taxed segments of society. They said the government wanted to abolish the super tax for wealthy individuals and the corporate sector. The proposal would now be taken up with the IMF after the endorsement by the prime minister.

**Oil prices surge 20% on supply fears as US-Israeli war with Iran expands:** (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices surged about 20% in early trade on Monday, hitting their highest since July 2022, as the expanding U.S.-Israeli war with Iran fuelled fears of tighter supply and prolonged disruptions to shipments through the Strait of Hormuz. Brent crude futures rose as much as \$18.35, or 19.8%, to \$111.04 a barrel and were up \$14.38, or 15.5%, at \$107.07 as of 2314 GMT. US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures were up \$15.27, or 16.8%, at \$106.17, after rising as much as \$20.34, or 22.4%, to \$111.24 earlier in the session.

Exporters and industrialists have rejected the government's decision of surge in petroleum product prices by Rs55 per litre, warning that the move will significantly raise industrial production costs and deal a serious blow to Pakistan's exports, while also affecting the prime minister's "Uraan Pakistan" vision.

A week into one of the biggest ever disruptions to global energy markets, oil prices still remain far below levels seen in previous crises. But a growing chorus of energy executives and traders is warning that every day that war rages on brings the world closer to a tipping point — with several predicting \$100 crude within days, according to Bloomberg.

**SBP unlikely to change rates next week on inflation worries amid surging oil prices:** (Economy: Neutral)

The State Bank of Pakistan is expected to keep interest rates unchanged at a monetary policy meeting on Monday, analysts said, as the fluctuating oil prices and the widening Middle East conflict create uncertainty around inflation and limit potential for monetary easing. The central bank held the policy rate at 10.5 per cent in January and has reduced the benchmark rate by a cumulative 11.5 percentage points since mid-2024, down from a record high of 22 per cent.

Chief of Army Staff and Chief of Defence Forces Field Marshal Syed Asim Munir visited the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) and met Prince Khalid Bin Salman, the defence minister of Saudi Arabia, to discuss measures to stop Iranian attacks on the Kingdom within the framework of Strategic Mutual Defence Agreement (SMDA). It was stressed that unprovoked aggression undermines efforts towards regional security and stability and precludes options for peaceful settlement of disputes.

**Saudi Arabia requested for \$5bn deposit for 10 years, \$5bn oil facility:** (Economy: Neutral)

Pakistan has made eight requests to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) under long-term economic cooperation, including conversion of short-term existing deposits of \$5 billion into a long-term facility of 10 years, enhancing oil facility on deferred payment from \$1.2 billion to \$5 billion with increased tenure, securitisation of Pakistani diaspora's remittances of \$10 billion and others.

**Oil sector seen gaining Rs55bn from fuel hike:** (Economy: Negative) (OMCs: Positive)

The oil sector, including petroleum dealers and oil marketing companies (OMCs), is estimated to have gained around Rs55 billion overnight in inventory value after the government increased the prices of petrol and high-speed diesel (HSD) by Rs55 per litre each. Information gathered by The News regarding available stocks of petrol and HSD suggests that the sector earned substantial gains following the price increase.

The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (Nepra) has imposed fines totaling Rs 75 million on Quetta Electric Supply Company (QESCO) and Peshawar Electric Supply Company (PESCO) for violations related to AT&C-based load shedding and failure to improve transmission and distribution (T&D) losses and recovery respectively.

**SECP registers 3,444 new companies in February:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) registered 3,444 new companies in February, bringing the total number of registered companies in the country to 287,049, reflecting continued growth in Pakistan's corporate sector. Private limited companies accounted for 59 percent of the new registrations, followed by single-member companies at 38 percent. The remaining 3 percent comprised public unlisted companies, not-for-profit organizations, limited liability partnerships, and foreign companies.

Jazz International Holding Limited, the UAE-incorporated subsidiary of VEON and operator of Jazz in Pakistan, has signed an agreement to acquire a controlling stake in TPL Insurance Limited for approximately Rs4.15 billion. The deal, involving shares held by TPL Corp Limited, is expected to be completed in the second quarter of 2026, subject to regulatory approvals including clearance from the Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP), according to a press release issued. TPL Insurance is a digital-first insurer offering auto, health, fire, and property insurance products through its established distribution network.
