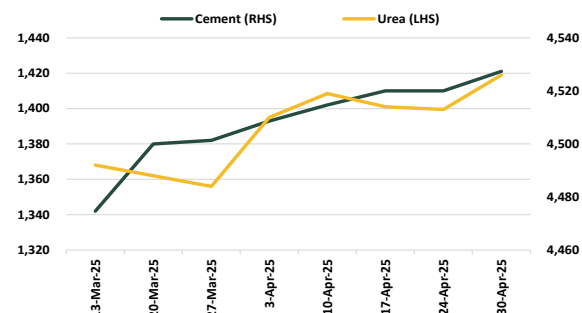

Ministry seeks Rs1.6trn PSDP: FY26 budget on June 2: (Economy: Neutral)

The federal government Thursday announced that federal budget for fiscal year 2025-26 will be presented on June 2, with the Planning Ministry seeking a development allocation of at least Rs1,600 billion – significantly higher than the Rs921 billion ceiling proposed so far by the Finance Ministry. Ahsan Iqbal said Finance Ministry has shared a resource envelope of just Rs921 billion for development programme for budget 2025-26 against the least requirement of Rs1,600 billion compared to estimated Rs2,900 billion by Planning Ministry for overall development programmes.

SBP reserves rise \$118m in a week: (Economy: Positive)

The foreign exchange reserves held by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) increased by \$118.1 million or 1.16% WoW to \$10.33 billion during the week ended on May 02, 2025, data released by the State Bank of Pakistan showed on Thursday. Similarly, the country's total reserves increased by \$230.8m or 1.51% WoW to \$15.48bn. The reserves held by commercial banks rose by \$112.7m or 2.24% WoW to \$5.15bn.

Fiscal deficit narrows to Rs2.97tr in Q3FY25: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan recorded a fiscal deficit of Rs2.97 trillion (-2.4% of GDP) in the third quarter of fiscal year 2025, as compared to a fiscal deficit of Rs3.9tr (-3.7% of GDP) in the same period of last year, as per data reported by Finance Ministry. Meanwhile, the primary surplus stood at Rs3.46tr (2.8% of GDP) in Q3FY25 as against a primary surplus of Rs1.61tr (1.5% of GDP) in Q3FY24. The government plugged the fiscal deficit through domestic borrowing of Rs1.62tr but saw a net outflow of Rs78.7 billion in external financing. In the same period last year, the government's borrowings to aid the budget deficit included an amount of Rs2.95tr borrowed domestically, and Rs19.5bn through external financing.

Pakistan makes large US soybean purchase as tensions with India rise: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Pakistan has made its biggest purchase of U.S. soybeans in nearly three years, the U.S. Department of Agriculture said on Thursday, as the nation resumes imports of genetically engineered soy. The purchases will only partially offset U.S. farmers' lost sales to top soy importer China because of President Donald Trump's trade war with Beijing. More than half of U.S. soybean exports are normally to China, while Pakistan's total imports in 2021 totaled just 1.4% of U.S. shipments abroad, according to U.S. government data.

IMF reaffirms support for Pakistan's bailout, calls for deesclation with India: (Economy: Neutral)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) on Thursday reiterated that its Executive Board meeting pertaining to Pakistan's bailout programme will proceed as planned on May 9, 2025. "The IMF supports Pakistan's economic program through its EFF, which is specifically designed to build reserves and help reforms aligned with the objectives of the EFF, which are to restore macroeconomic policy credibility, build resilience including through stronger buffers, and create stronger inclusive growth," the lender said.

Indo-Pak conflict chokes trade routes: (Economy: Negative)

Amid intensifying tensions between India and Pakistan, regional trade flows have taken a major hit as global shipping lines have suspended operations to Karachi and are rerouting cargo. Exporters and logistics providers have confirmed to Mettis Global that shipments are now facing significant delays, while freight charges are witnessing a sharp upward revision. Pakistan's access to key international markets via India's Mundra Port, frequently used for shipments to Europe, has effectively come to a standstill. Both countries have enforced restrictions on each other's cargo, leading to growing reluctance among international carriers to engage in regional docking.

S&P warns of elevated credit risks amid soaring Pakistan-India military tensions: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

S&P Global Ratings, an American credit rating agency, on Thursday warned that heightened tensions between Pakistan and India following an outbreak of hostilities have amplified regional credit risks. In a statement, the global rating agency said it expects intense military actions between the countries to be temporary, leading to contained confrontations. However, it cautioned that miscalculations could significantly erode credit risks for both sovereigns.

Pakistan targets \$500m sorghum exports to China: TDAP: (Economy: Neutral)

Pakistan is positioning itself to tap into China's \$2.6 billion sorghum import market, aiming to revive domestic cultivation of the drought-resistant crop and seize a \$500 million export opportunity within a decade, officials said at a seminar on Thursday. The crop, once widely grown in Pakistan, has seen production plummet by 89 per cent since 1994, shrinking from 438,200 hectares to just 46,697 hectares by 2023, according to TDAP.
