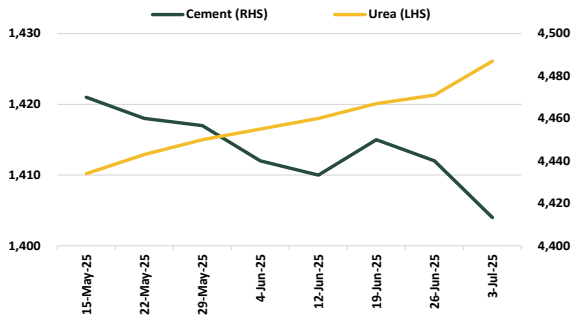

Local Indices				Forex reserves cross \$20bn mark after three years: (Economy: Positive) In a major development to the country’s external account, Pakistan’s total liquid foreign exchange reserves have surged past the \$20 billion mark for the first time in three years, driven by strong foreign inflows. According to the weekly report issued by the SBP on Thursday, the country’s total liquid foreign exchange reserves increased by \$1.94 billion during the previous week. FIPI				Pakistan to import 350,000 tons of sugar in two phases to rein in prices: (Economy: Positive) Pakistan will import 350,000 metric tons of sugar in a two-stage strategy aimed at stabilizing domestic prices and ensuring sufficient supplies, the Ministry of National Food Security & Research revealed on Wednesday. Under the plan, the Trading Corporation of Pakistan (TCP) will first issue a tender for 200,000 tons of sugar, followed by a second tender for an additional 150,000 tons to be floated a week later. The phased approach is designed to align imports with immediate market needs and expected demand over the coming weeks. 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Pakistan signs €20mn grant deal with EU to boost governance, business environment: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan and the European Union (EU) on Thursday signed a €20 million grant agreement to launch the "Better Governance and Business Environment" initiative, aimed at strengthening governance and improving competitiveness of the private sector, particularly small and medium enterprises (SMEs). The agreement was signed by EU Ambassador Dr Riina Kionka and Secretary Economic Affairs Division Dr Kazim Niaz. The programme is part of the EU's Multiannual Indicative Programme 2021-2027.

Pakistan eves \$1 billion valuation in Roosevelt Hotel redevelopment plan, source says: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan is seeking a valuation of at least \$1 billion for the Roosevelt Hotel it owns in New York and is ready to part with a minority stake in the prime Manhattan property as it scouts for a redevelopment partner. As part of its \$7bn IMF-backed privatisation push, the government approved a "transaction structure for the Roosevelt Hotel" on Tuesday, saying it won't do an outright sale but has decided to adopt a joint venture model to maximise long-term value.

PM unveils scheme for soft agricultural loans: (Economy: Positive) (Agriculture: Positive)

Prime Minister unveiled a scheme for offering soft agricultural loans to farmers under the Public Private Partnership (PPP) model. Presiding over a review meeting on development of the agriculture sector, the prime minister directed the authorities concerned to formulate a strategy for sustainable agricultural reforms in collaboration with provinces. The PM issued directives for urgent reforms in the Zarai Taraqqiati Bank for transparent provision of easy loans to farmers. He said the coming Public Sector Development Programme (PSDP) would prioritise agricultural projects, focusing on mechanisation, digitisation, easy access to loans for farmers, and creating a business-friendly environment.

Russian minister terms Islamabad and Moscow "natural allies", reaffirms bilateral cooperation (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Russia's Deputy Prime Minister Alexei Overchuk said Pakistan and Russia were "natural allies", stressing that Russian President views Islamabad as an important strategic partner in the areas of economy and energy, the Foreign Office said in a statement. In a high-level meeting with Ambassador Fatemi and the prime minister's aide on Industries and Production, Haroon Akhtar Khan, in Moscow, the Russian DPM reaffirmed his country's commitment towards deepening bilateral cooperation with Pakistan. "He also highlighted the significance of important connectivity projects between two countries, such as the railway connectivity between Uzbekistan, Pakistan and Russia, and the launching of a pilot cargo train between Pakistan and Russia in August 2025."

To jumpstart operations, KCCL will lease one of its investment properties to Ultra Properties, which will construct multi-story commercial buildings for rental income, marking a strategic diversification beyond cement manufacturing.
