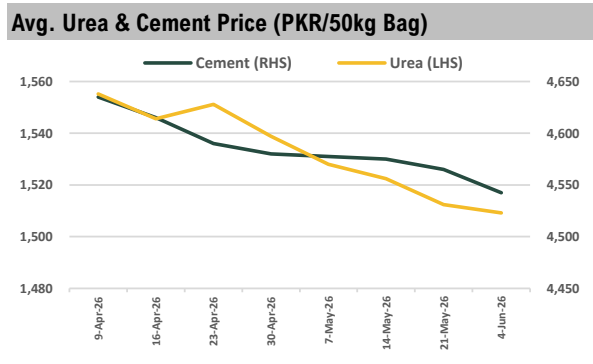

4pc growth target set: Rs3.669trn uplift outlay approved by economic council:
(Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The National Economic Council (NEC) on Wednesday approved a Rs3.669 trillion national development outlay for the fiscal year 2026-27, including Rs838 billion in foreign aid, and set a GDP growth target of 4 percent. The meeting, chaired by Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, also sanctioned Rs1 trillion for the federal Public Sector Development Programme (PSDP), Rs2.218 trillion for provincial development programmes, and Rs451 billion for state-owned enterprises (SOEs). The NEC unanimously approved a four-point agenda and revised economic indicators for the outgoing fiscal year 2025-26, allocating Rs820 billion for the federal PSDP, Rs2,938 billion for provincial development programmes, and Rs355 billion for SOEs. The council approved a GDP growth target of 3.7 percent for 2025-26.

US launches new strikes after Trump threatens to attack Iran 'very hard':
(Economy: Negative)

The United States began a fresh round of strikes against multiple targets overnight in Iran, the US military said on Wednesday, hours after President Donald Trump vowed new attacks if no peace deal is secured. "The strikes are in response to Iran's unwarranted and continued aggression," the military's Central Command said in a post on X, adding that the strikes began at 5:15 p.m. EDT (2115 GMT), which was 12:45 a.m. in Tehran. The attacks are the latest development in an escalating exchange of strikes that threaten to reignite a full-scale war, which was paused in early April when the two sides agreed to a fragile ceasefire. An explosion was heard in the port city of Sirik, and air defenses were activated in west Tehran, Iran's Mehr news agency reported.

Oil rises \$2 as Iran announces closure of Strait of Hormuz following US strikes:
(Economy: Negative)

Oil prices climbed more than \$2 a barrel Thursday as Iran declared the critical energy chokepoint, the Strait of Hormuz, closed after the US launched additional strikes against Iran. Brent futures rose \$2.30, or 2.47%, to \$95.40 a barrel, while US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude climbed \$2.60, or 2.89%, to \$92.63. US crude futures gained more than \$3 earlier in the session. Iran's top joint military command announced the closure of the Strait of Hormuz on Thursday, including oil tankers and commercial ships, saying any vessel that will attempt passage will be shot at.

Stock market, stationery items and solar panels: Tax rates to remain unchanged:
(Economy: Neutral)

The taxation on stock market, stationery items and solar panels would remain the same in budget (2026-27). According to sources, the proposal to increase sales tax from 10 to 18 percent on solar panels has been dropped. Similarly, the proposed increase in sales tax on stationery items would not be implemented in coming budget. Stock market taxes would not be changed from July 1, 2026. The proposed reduction in taxes for the real estate sector has yet not been finalized.

World Bank approves additional USD300m financing for T4HP: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The World Bank (WB) has approved an additional USD 300 million in financing for the Tarbela Fourth Extension Hydropower Project (T4HP) to help cover cost overruns associated with the Tarbela Fifth Extension Hydropower Project (T5HP). Official sources revealed that the government had sought the additional financing of USD 300 million from the Bank for T4HP. This amount will be the final tranche of investment from the World Bank to help achieve the outcomes envisaged under T5HP. T5HP is at an advanced stage of construction, with progress described as highly satisfactory, and commissioning of the generation units is expected in July 2027.

Pakistan receives a record USD 4.25bn monthly remittances in May 2026: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan received a record USD 4.25 billion in workers' remittances in May 2026, the highest monthly inflow ever recorded, offering a significant boost to the country's external account and foreign exchange reserves. The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) on Wednesday reported that workers' remittances maintained their strong growth momentum, rising by 20.2 percent month-on-month and 15.4 percent year-on-year in May 2026. Pakistan received USD 4.25 billion in remittances in May 2026, compared to USD 3.57 billion in April 2026 and USD 3.685 billion in May 2025, reflecting the continued confidence and support of overseas Pakistanis for the country's economy. This marks only the second time in Pakistan's history that monthly remittances have crossed the USD 4 billion threshold. The previous record of USD 4.05 billion was recorded in March 2025.

Petrol braces for hike, diesel set for massive drop: (Economy: Negative)

After weeks of relative relief for petrol consumers, shifting global oil market Dynamics indicate that petrol prices are on track to climb, while High-Speed Diesel (HSD) rates are poised for a massive drop. According to the latest working data dated June 10, 2026, the international pricing benchmarks have flipped. Petrol is expected to rise by around Rs10.24 per litre, while High-Speed Diesel (HSD) is projected to witness a substantial reduction of Rs19.10 per litre in the upcoming fortnightly review. Petrol is facing upward pressure due to a spike in global premiums and import costs. On the other hand, diesel has registered a steep decline on the back of falling global product values.

Govt raises Rs1.9tr via T-bill auction: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The government raised Rs1.902 trillion (realised value) from the auction of market treasury bills on Wednesday, while yields were mixed ahead of the central bank's monetary policy meeting next week. The one-month T-bill cut-off yield fell 4 basis points to 12.1892 per cent. The yield on the three-month paper increased one basis point to 12.4988 per cent. The six-month T-bill yield was down 1 basis point to 12.4999 per cent. The 12-month T-bill yield increased 40 basis points to 12.9895 per cent. The government raised Rs1.962 trillion (face value) from the T-bill auction against the target of Rs2 trillion, with a maturity of Rs1.835 trillion. The participation in the auction was Rs4.63 trillion. The government rejected bids for the Pakistan Investment Bonds (floaters) in a separate auction.

\$4.5bn refinery planned in Hub: (Economy: Neutral)

Pakistan is set to establish its first deep-conversion greenfield refinery project in Hub, Balochistan, involving an investment of \$4.5 billion and the creation of around 2,000 jobs. SPEC Refinery Pvt Ltd Chairman Zafar Sheikh held a meeting with Commerce Minister Jam Kamal to review progress on the project, which is being described as a major step towards strengthening the country's energy security. An official statement said the delegation briefed the commerce minister on the project's progress and highlighted its strategic importance in reducing reliance on imported refined petroleum products, enhancing energy security, and promoting industrial development. The proposed refinery will employ advanced deep-conversion technology to maximize the production of high-value petroleum products while processing a wide range of crude oil grades sourced from international markets.

Income tax may fall for some salaried segments: (Economy: Neutral)

Significant relief is planned for salaried individuals earning between Rs230,000 and Rs341,000 a month in the upcoming budget, but a large segment of those making between Rs100,000 and Rs183,000 per month may not see any change. Individuals earning between Rs230,000 and Rs300,000 a month are expected to see a steep reduction in their tax burden. A significant reduction is also planned for individuals earning between Rs266,000 and Rs341,000 a month, whose current slab carries a liability of Rs28,833 plus 30pc of income above Rs266,000. Additionally, the maximum salary tax rate is under consideration for a cut to around 30pc from the existing 35pc.
