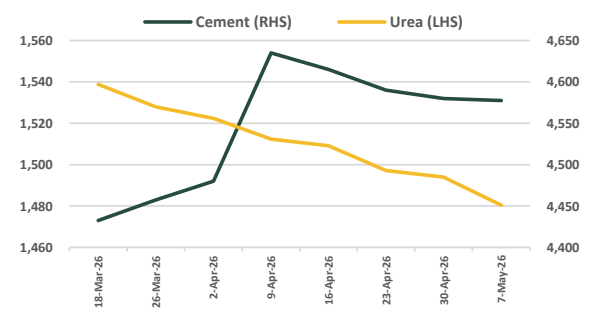

Trump rejects ‘unacceptable’ Iranian terms for ending war: (Economy: Negative)
President Donald Trump has rejected Iran’s formal response to the latest US proposal, conveyed through Pakistani mediators, aimed at ending the ongoing Gulf conflict, as diplomatic efforts become increasingly strained amid continued military preparations and repeated ceasefire violations across the region. “I have just read the response from Iran’s so-called ‘Representatives.’ I don’t like it TOTALLY UNACCEPTABLE,” Trump posted on his Truth Social platform, without providing details of the response.

IMF clears Pakistan’s next \$1.2bn tranche: (Economy: Positive)
The Executive Board of International Monetary Fund (IMF) on Friday approved the latest review of Pakistan’s ongoing reform programme, clearing the way for the release of about \$1.2 billion in financing under its existing arrangements. The disbursement includes roughly \$1 billion under the Extended Fund Facility (EFF) and about \$210 million under the Resilience and Sustainability Facility (RSF). With this tranche, total disbursements under the current programme rise to approximately \$4.5 billion.

IMF budget talks begin next week: (Economy: Neutral)
Talks between Pakistan and the International Monetary Fund (IMF) to secure approval for next year’s budget before its presentation in the National Assembly are set to begin on Wednesday, including finalising proposals to impose about Rs230 billion in net additional taxes. The government will also share a new tax scheme for traders with the IMF, which envisages imposing 1% of turnover as income tax.

Pakistan must keep fuel, electricity, gas prices in line with costs: IMF: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)
While approving tranches worth \$1.3 billion for Pakistan, the IMF has made it clear that amid volatile commodity prices, Pakistan will keep domestic fuel, electricity and gas prices aligned with actual costs while protecting vulnerable consumers through targeted subsidies and support. The IMF projected Pakistan’s GDP growth at 3.5pc for the next fiscal year (FY27), while inflation is expected to rebound to 8.4pc. Gross foreign exchange reserves are projected to reach \$17.5 billion by June 2026.

Budget may include income tax relief amid salary, pension freeze: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)
The government is considering reducing the income tax burden on salaried individuals while refraining from increasing salaries and pensions in the upcoming budget, aiming to provide equitable fiscal relief to both public and private sector employees. Finance Minister has expressed a desire to lower tax rates and, if possible, raise the taxable income threshold for the salaried class in recognition of their significant contribution to revenue generation compared to retailers, wholesalers, exporters, and real estate players.

World food prices climbed in April to their highest in more than three years, with vegetable oils particularly elevated due to the Iran war and the effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz, the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) said on Friday.

Petrol, diesel prices hiked by Rs15 per litre each: (Economy: Negative)

The federal government has increased petrol and diesel prices by nearly Rs15 per litre each for the next week. The price of petrol has jumped from Rs399.86 to Rs414.78, while the HSD price increased from Rs399.58 to Rs414.58 per litre. This marks the third consecutive increase in petrol and diesel prices after cumulative hikes of Rs33.28 on petrol and Rs46.39 on diesel over the previous two weeks.

Weekly inflation up by 0.79pc: (Economy: Negative)

The Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) based weekly inflation increased by 0.79 per cent during the week ended on May 07, 2026, for the combined consumption group, the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS) reported on Friday. According to PBS data, SPI for the week under review rose to 357.04 points as compared to 354.23 points recorded in the previous week. On a year-on-year (YoY) basis, the SPI increased by 15.16 per cent.

Qatar makes another attempt to send LNG shipment: (Economy: Positive)

A tanker carrying liquefied natural gas from Qatar is attempting to transit the Strait of Hormuz, which, if successful, would mark the country's first export out of the region since the Iran war began, reports Bloomberg. The Al Kharaitiyat, which loaded at the Ras Laffan export plant earlier this month, is currently in the waterway between Oman and Iran, ship-tracking data compiled by Bloomberg shows. The vessel lists Pakistan as its next destination, according to the data.

Tariff subsidies, surcharges: PD to sign PSO-Discos deals: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Power Division is to sign Public Service Obligations (PSO) agreements with the power Distribution Companies (DISCOs) on management and administration of tariff subsidies and relief packages and collection and deposit of surcharges under the NEPRA Act, well informed sources told Business Recorder. Historically, the DISCOS have been performing certain public service obligations on behalf of the Federal Government, including the management and administration of government-funded subsidies such as tariff differential subsidies, tariff relief packages, and specific discounts, as well as the collection of statutory surcharges.

July-March foreign aid inflows up by 19.73%: EAD: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Foreign assistance inflows to Pakistan increased by 19.73 percent during the July-March period of fiscal year 2025-26, reaching USD6.59 billion compared to USD5.50 billion during the corresponding period last year. According to statistics released by the Economic Affairs Division (EAD), bilateral grants during July-March 2025-26 stood at USD43.61 million. Major contributors included China with USD10.57 million, Japan USD19.20 million, Germany USD9 million, and Saudi Arabia USD3.31 million.

RDA hits record \$321m in April: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Total inflows into Roshan Digital Accounts (RDA) during April, 2026 stood at \$321 million, bringing the total cumulative inflows into RDA to \$12,747 million. Compared to the previous month's inflow of \$261, April showed an increase of \$60 million. However, according to data released by the SBP, amount repatriated and locally utilized during the month was \$191 million showing that the Net Repatriable Liability of RDA increased by \$130 million in April.

He claimed that the Punjab government has unofficially stopped wheat supply to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, creating a serious shortage of wheat and flour in the province.

PSX launches new "Apparel" sector: (Economy: Neutral)

The Pakistan Stock Exchange (PSX) has formally introduced a dedicated "Apparel" sector, which marks a structural shift in how the bourse categorizes companies primarily engaged in the apparel business. The move, in a notice on the exchange to all market participants, reflects PSX's ongoing effort to align its sectoral classifications more closely with the actual economic activities of listed companies.

PPL brings Faiz X-1 well on stream after decade: (Economy: Positive) (PPL: Positive)

Pakistan Petroleum Limited (PPL) has successfully commissioned Faiz X-1 Deep (Basal Sand) at its operated Gambat South Block in Sanghar, Sindh, according to a statement issued on Saturday. Production was ramped up in stages since its commissioning on February 25, 2026, currently flowing about 3.6 million standard cubic feet per day (MMscfd) of gas and 750 barrels per day (bpd) of condensate after optimisation of operational parameters. Drilled in 2014, the Faiz X-1 discovery could not be developed earlier because of the absence of nearby pipeline infrastructure.
