<b>Local Indices</b>			<p><b>Aurangzeb hopeful of deal with IMF this month on \$6bn package:</b> (Economy: Positive)            Claiming completion of almost all prior action before time and reaching an agreement, in principle, with all provinces over agricultural income tax, Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb sounded hopeful on Thursday that talks with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) would yield a deal on a \$6bn Extended Fund Facility (EFF) this month. During the visit, the president will hold meetings with Prime Minister Shehbaz and President Asif Ali Zardari. Total liquid foreign reserves held by the country stood at \$14.64 billion. Net foreign reserves held by commercial banks stood at \$5.24 billion. At close, the currency settled at 278.61, a loss of Re0.10 against the greenback. On Wednesday, the local unit had settled at 278.51 against the US dollar.  <a href="https://www.brecorder.com/news/40312391/">https://www.brecorder.com/news/40312391/</a></p> <p><b>Government borrows Rs3.2tr in 45 days:</b> (Economy: Negative)            The government borrowed Rs3.2 trillion from scheduled banks from May 15 to June 28 of the fiscal year 2023-24, despite a 30 per cent growth in revenue generation. The latest State Bank data shows that the government borrowed Rs71.8bn per day during the period, reflecting the government's massive spending of the government. In the budget for FY25, the government has resorted to heavy taxation in order to generate 40 per cent more revenue than what it did the previous fiscal year. ### **Govt targets 15m annual cotton production by 2025:** (Economy: Neutral)

Pakistan's annual cotton production currently stands at 8.4 million bales, and the government is committed to increasing it to 15m bales by 2025, stated Federal Minister for Industries, Production, and National Food Security Rana Tanveer Hussain on Thursday. The minister reiterated the government's commitment to promote the cotton industry, as APP reported. He said this while addressing the meeting of the Pakistan Central Cotton Committee's governing body

### **Flour shortage feared as millers go on strike:** (Economy: Negative)

Urban consumers are bracing for a potential shortage of flour as the All-Pakistan Flour Mills Association (PFMA) went on a nationwide strike on Thursday in protest against the newly imposed withholding tax. Owners of atta chakkis (small wheat grinding units) and flour dealers in various towns have also joined the strike, leading to significant disruptions in flour supply across many urban centres. PFMA Chairman Asim Raza has vowed to continue the strike until the association's demands are met.

### **Cement prices surge in Pakistan:** (Economy: Negative)

Cement prices in Pakistan recorded the largest weekly gain in at least seven years, posing a risk to already subdued consumer demand in the near future. Retail price per 50kg bag jumped 10.4% to Rs1,409 compared to Rs1,276 a week before, according to data released by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics. That is a gain of Rs133 per bag in Rupee terms.

### **NA passes SOEs Bill 2024:** (Economy: Neutral)

The National Assembly on Wednesday passed the State-Owned Enterprises (Governance and Operations) (Amendment) Bill, 2024, aimed at strengthening the provisions for the removal of directors under the Act, amid the opposition uproar, as APP reported. Minister for Law and Justice Azam Nazeer Tarar on behalf of the Minister for Finance and Revenue piloted the bill in the House to amend the State-Owned Enterprises (Governance and Operations) Act, 2023 as passed by the Senate. In the proposed changes, future board directors, including government and independent members, would undergo performance evaluations by the board's nomination committee.

### **SBP revises regulations to aid IT exporters:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

To further facilitate export-oriented companies, particularly those operating in the IT sector, the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) has revised its Foreign Exchange Manual (FEM). "In order to further facilitate export oriented companies, particularly those operating in the IT sector, in expanding their footprints abroad and increase the exports of the country, the provisions of Para 13(II)A of Chapter 20 of Foreign Exchange Manual (FEM) have been revised," said a circular issued by the Exchange Policy Department of SBP. The major revisions include the introduction of a new EIA category for export-oriented companies operating in the IT sector.
