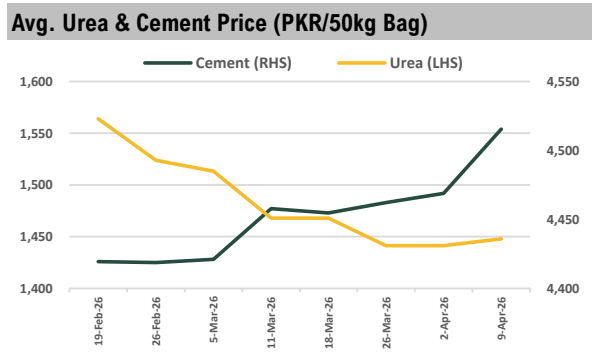

US-Iran talks end without deal: (Economy: Negative)

The US and Iran failed to reach an agreement to end their war despite marathon talks that concluded on Sunday here, jeopardising a fragile ceasefire. Each side blamed the other for the failure of the 21-hour negotiations to end fighting that has killed thousands, roiled the global economy and sent oil prices soaring since it began more than six weeks ago.

Oil jumps 7% to above \$100 ahead of US blockade on Iran: (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices jumped above \$100 a barrel on Monday as the US Navy prepared to block ships from reaching Iran via the Strait of Hormuz, a move that could restrict Iranian oil exports, after Washington and Tehran failed to reach a deal to end the war. Brent crude futures rose \$6.71, or 7.05%, to \$101.91 a barrel by 0104 GMT after settling 0.75% lower on Friday. US West Texas Intermediate was at \$104.16 a barrel, up \$7.59, or 7.86%, following a 1.33% loss in the previous session.

Saudi Arabia, Qatar to provide \$5bn assistance to Pakistan: report: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Saudi Arabia and Qatar will provide Pakistan \$5 billion in financial assistance, enabling Islamabad to avert stress on the country's weak foreign reserves while making external payments by June, Pakistani official sources told Anadolu on Saturday, the news agency reported. The development comes as Islamabad is set to repay a \$3.5 billion debt to the UAE by the end of the month.

Pak-Iran transit corridor opened: (Economy: Positive)

Director Transit Trade Customs Sanaullah Abro told The Express Tribune that the inaugural shipment, comprising frozen meat, was transported via refrigerated trucks to Tashkent, Uzbekistan. He said that under the corridor, consignments from Pakistan would be routed through Gwadar and Iran onwards to the Central Asian states.

ADB sees GDP growth at 3.5pc in FY26, 4.5pc in next fiscal year: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has projected Pakistan's GDP growth to accelerate to 3.5 percent in fiscal year 2026 and 4.5 percent in fiscal year 2027, with inflation estimated at 6.4 percent and 6.5 percent, respectively. Despite recent stabilization and recovery, Pakistan's economic outlook faces significant downside risks from global economic uncertainty, leading to elevated inflationary, fiscal, and external account pressures. Addressing these challenges requires prudent macroeconomic policies and steadfast implementation of structural reforms, the Bank noted in its latest report Asian Development Outlook (ADO).

Weekly SPI-based inflation up 1.93pc: (Economy: Negative)

The Sensitive Price Index (SPI)-based inflation for the week ending April 9 increased by 1.93 percent, mainly due to hike in the prices of diesel by 54.71 percent, petrol 17.86 percent, tomatoes 9.35 percent, and Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) 8.61 percent, according to weekly data released on Friday by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS).

HSD price slashed by Rs135, petrol's by Rs12: (Economy: Positive)

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Friday announced a reduction in fuel prices following a decline in international oil rates, cutting diesel by Rs135 per litre and petrol by Rs12 per litre, effective from midnight on Saturday. In a televised address, the prime minister said the measure was aimed at easing the burden of inflation, which he described as "crushing the nation."

RDA attracts \$261m in March: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan received inflows of \$261 million through the Roshan Digital Account (RDA) in March, an increase from \$242 million in the previous month, data from the State Bank of Pakistan showed on Friday. Since its launch in September 2020, the RDA has attracted a total of \$12.426 billion in funds. The programme continues to grow, with the number of digital accounts reaching 917,400 as of March, up from 909,407 in the previous month.

PD shelve USD36bn circular debt refinancing plan: (Economy: Negative)

The Power Division had shared its plan with IFIs and Saudi Arabia to secure loans worth \$36 billion over 13 years, starting from FY2027, to refinance the power sector's debt servicing burden. The objective was to reduce electricity tariffs, particularly for the industrial sector. In December 2025, Power Division had also shared its circular debt refinancing plan with the Prime Minister, Shehbaz Sharif. Currently, the power sector's circular debt stands at around Rs 1.9 trillion. However, the government aims to contain it at Rs 1.614 trillion by June 30, 2026. The government has already raised Rs 1.225 trillion from commercial banks to reduce circular debt and has decided to continue the recovery of the Debt Service Charge at Rs 3.23 per kWh for the next six years in an effort to bring the stock down to zero.

Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL) and Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (SSGCL) will work with the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) and the Task Force on Power to calculate the extra profit earned by keeping gas prices unchanged while switching from expensive imported RLNG to cheaper domestic gas.
