

**IMF, govt to continue talks on EFF review: (Economy: Neutral)**

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) team and the Pakistani authorities will continue discussions on the third review of the 37-month Extended Fund Facility (EFF) and the second review of 28-month arrangement under the Resilience and Sustainability Facility (RSF) with a view to conclude them in the coming days. While considerable progress was made in the discussions, these will continue in the coming days, including to more fully assess the impact of recent global developments on Pakistan's economy and the EFF-supported program, said IMF team lead. <https://www.brecorder.com/news/40411440/>

**RLNG jumps 22% on global oil price surge: (Economy: Negative)**

The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) on Thursday notified a sharp 19-22 per cent increase in the price of regasified liquefied natural gas (RLNG) for March at the distribution stage for the country's two Sui gas companies. The increase comes mainly due to higher terminal charges, a slight rise in import prices and a reduction in imported LNG cargoes, according to data released by the regulator. The hike marks a rare spike in RLNG prices, following a marginal 0.5% increase in February and two consecutive reductions in December (6%) and January (5%). Earlier, RLNG prices had risen by a combined 4.4% during October and November. For SSGCL, the RLNG sale price at the transmission stage increased 22% to \$11.12 per mmBtu for March, compared with \$9.03 per mmBtu in February. At the distribution stage, SSGCL's RLNG price rose 22% to \$12.54 per mmBtu, compared with \$10.27 per mmBtu in February. <https://tribune.com.pk/story/2597360/rlng-jumps-22-on-global-oil-price-surge>

**Fuel price hike pushes weekly inflation up: (Economy: Negative)**

Pakistan's short-term inflation indicator recorded a notable increase, as the Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) rose 6.44% year-on-year during the week ended March 11, 2026, mainly driven by a sharp rise in energy and essential food prices, according to data released by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS). On a week-on-week basis, the SPI increased by 1.89%, reflecting a significant jump in the cost of key household commodities. The rise was largely attributed to a surge in petroleum product prices following recent adjustments in fuel rates due to the US-Israel war on Iran. Among the major contributors, petrol prices increased by 20.60% while diesel surged by 19.54% compared to the previous week. Similarly, the price of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) rose by 12.13%, putting additional pressure on household budgets, particularly in areas where LPG is widely used for cooking. <https://tribune.com.pk/story/2597372/fuel-price-hike-pushes-weekly-inflation-up>

**SBP reserves rise \$41.1m to \$16.34bn: (Economy: Positive)**

The foreign exchange reserves held by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) increased by \$41.1 million or 0.25% WoW to \$16.34 billion during the week ended on March 06, 2026, data released by State Bank of Pakistan showed on Thursday. Similarly, the country's total reserves increased by \$164.4m or 0.77% WoW to \$21.6bn. **Govt issues no statement on further petrol price hike: (Economy: Neutral)**

No statement has been issued regarding a further increase in petrol prices in the country, which dismisses reports circulating on some television channels as incorrect. The clarification came after Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb briefed the Senate Standing Committee on Finance and Revenue, where he only informed members about the rising trend in crude oil prices in the international market. **Pakistan turns Hormuz crisis into maritime opportunity:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan has successfully secured alternative fuel supply routes as geopolitical tensions triggered the closure of the Strait of Hormuz, with four fuel vessels bypassing standard Middle Eastern chokepoints to deliver energy cargo to Karachi's ports, simultaneously capitalising on regional shipping disruptions to cement its role as a rising transshipment hub. Port Qasim Authority (PQA) confirmed Thursday that operations are proceeding efficiently across multiple berths and terminals, ensuring a steady flow of fuel products to domestic consumers and industry, despite the mounting regional crisis choking traditional maritime corridors.

**PNSC says no vessels stuck at Hormuz as two ships en route:** (Economy: Positive)

Two vessels of the Pakistan National Shipping Corporation (PNSC) are on schedule to reach their destinations today, and no ships are currently stranded at the Strait of Hormuz, a PNSC spokesperson said on Thursday. The spokesperson's statement came in response to media reports suggesting that PNSC vessels were facing delays in the strategic waterway. "Two vessels of PNSC are on the way to reach [on Friday]. No vessel is stuck," the official said, dismissing concerns about maritime disruptions.

**Pakistan secures \$5.17bn foreign loans in first seven months of FY26:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan has secured dollar inflows in the shape of \$5.17 billion foreign loans in the first seven months (July-Jan) of the current fiscal year as against \$4.584 billion foreign loans fetched in the same period of the previous financial year. According to details shared by the Economic Affairs Division (EAD), the government preferred releasing the data on foreign loans and grants which got delayed, probably due to the review talks held between Pakistan and the IMF. As the parleys concluded, the EAD released the official data showing that the disbursement of foreign loans stood at \$5.17 billion during the July-January period of FY26 as against \$4.584 billion in the same period of the previous financial year.

**RDA attracts \$242m in February:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Total inflows into Roshan Digital Accounts (RDA) during February 2026 stood at \$241.8 million, bringing the total cumulative inflows into RDA to \$12.17 billion. Compared to the previous month's inflow of \$216.19 million, February showed an increase of \$25.61 million. However, according to data released by the SBP, the amount repatriated and locally utilized during the month was \$167.98 million, showing that the Net Repatriable Liability (NRL) of RDA increased by \$73.82 million in February. During the month, \$21.25 million was repatriated abroad while \$146.72 million was utilized locally.

**New values on import of chemicals issued:** (Economy: Positive)

Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi has issued new custom values on the import of chemicals i.e. Mono-Ethylene Glycol (MEG) and Di-Ethylene Glycol (DEG) from all origins. In this regard, the directorate has issued a new valuation ruling. According to the ruling, the matter for determination of customs values on the import of chemicals was earlier done in 2020.
