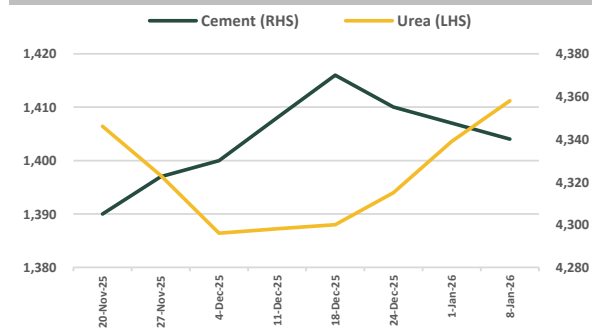

Pakistan on list as US suspends immigrant visas: (Economy: Negative)

The US State Department announced on Wednesday that it will suspend immigrant visa processing for Pakistan and 74 other countries, amid concerns that immigrants from these nations often rely on public welfare programmes, or fail security vetting. The freeze will begin on January 21, with no set time for it to end. According to AFP, the latest move does not affect tourist, business or other visas, including for soccer fans seeking to visit for this year's World Cup, although the Trump administration has vowed to vet all applicants' social media histories.

Oil prices sink more than 2% as Trump remarks calm concern about Iran: (Economy: Positive)

Oil prices slid more than 2% in early Asian trade on Thursday after U.S. President Donald Trump said killings in Iran's crackdown on nationwide protests were stopping, tempering concern over military action against Iran and supply disruption. Brent futures were down \$1.67, or 2.5%, at \$64.85 a barrel at 0109 GMT, while U.S. West Texas Intermediate crude slipped \$1.54, or 2.5%, to \$60.48 a barrel.

Several nations eying JF-17 jets, says PM: (Economy: Positive)

As a number of nations show interest in buying JF-17 Thunder jets from Pakistan, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Wednesday confirmed that several countries were in active talks with Islamabad to procure the fighter aircraft, which became a centre of attention following the India-Pakistan conflict in May last year. Indonesia, Bangladesh, Iraq, and Saudi Arabia have expressed interest in buying the fighter jets, while Azerbaijan inducted this aircraft into its air force in 2024. Azerbaijan had become the third country to acquire JF-17 fighters after Myanmar and Nigeria.

The Federal Constitutional Court (FCC) was asked to keep in mind 27th Constitutional Amendment and other factors while delivering judgement on Super Tax under Sections 4B and 4C. A three-member bench, headed by the Chief Justice Amin, on Wednesday heard the FBR appeals against the judgements of Sindh, Lahore and Islamabad High Courts regarding levy of Super Tax under Section 4C, inserted in the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 through Finance Act 2015.

Reasons behind exit of MNCs: Aurangzeb says it takes two to tango: (Economy: Neutral)

Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb on Wednesday acknowledged that steep taxes and soaring energy costs have pushed some multinational companies out of Pakistan, but insisted investor confidence remains intact as new local and foreign players continue to enter the market. However, the minister continued saying that it takes two to tango, if you are wedged into your business models from the last 50 years, it is not going to work in the modern world. Citing Nestle and Unilever as examples of MNCs successfully operating in Pakistan, he said, "If Nestle and Unilever can do local sourcing, which keeps their margins high, they are now able to export, which is why they continue operating here".

Govt to issue four RFPs for issuance of Panda, Dollar bonds: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The government is expected to issue four Request for Proposals (RFPs) in global markets for issuance of Panda bond and Dollar bond. This was informed during a meeting of the Debt Management Office of Ministry of Finance held with financial market participants at PSX to communicate their strategy and debt management plan through various new initiatives under pipeline. The 10-year Chinese bond currently yields less than 2 percent, while US bond of similar tenor yields between 4-4.5 percent, it added.

Punjab govt will buy only electric or hybrid cars: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Punjab government on Wednesday announced a complete ban on the purchase of petrol and diesel vehicles across its departments, allowing only electric or hybrid modes of transportation in a move aimed at cutting emissions and accelerating the transition to clean transport. As part of the same initiative, the approval of no-objection certificates (NOCs) for new petrol pumps has been made conditional on the installation of electric vehicle charging units.

Pakistan signs deal with Trump family-linked crypto firm: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan said on Wednesday it had signed an agreement with a firm connected to World Liberty Financial, the main crypto business of US President Donald Trump's family, to explore using World Liberty's \$1 stablecoin for cross-border payments. The announcement represents one of the first publicly announced tie-ups between World Liberty, a crypto-based finance platform launched in September 2024, and a sovereign state. It also comes amid a warming of ties between Pakistan and the United States. Under the agreement, SC Financial Technologies will work with Pakistan's central bank to integrate its \$1 stablecoin into a regulated digital payments structure, allowing the token to operate alongside Pakistan's own digital currency infrastructure, a source involved in the deal said.

Cross-subsidy slashed by Rs123b in two years: Power Division: (Economy: Positive) (Power: Positive)

The Power Division has announced that the industrial cross-subsidy burden has been reduced from Rs225 billion (Rs8.9 per unit) in March 2024, when the current government took charge, to Rs102 billion (Rs4.02 per unit) now, which represents a substantial reduction of Rs123 billion. The industrial tariff, including tax, dropped from Rs62.99 per unit in March 2024 to Rs46.31 per unit by December 2025, while the national average tariff decreased from Rs53.04 to Rs42.27 per unit, the division said in a statement issued on Wednesday.
