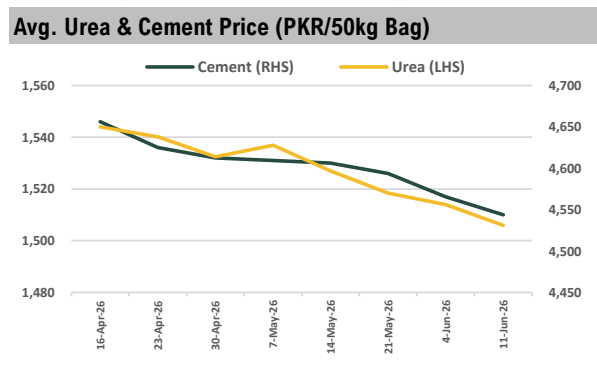

US, Iran reach peace deal, signing set for Friday, Pakistan says: (Economy: Positive)

The United States and Iran have reached a deal to end their war and will hold an official signing ceremony on Friday in Switzerland, Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif said on social media early on Monday. The agreement was struck despite an Israeli strike on Lebanon on Sunday that drew criticism from both Iran and US President Donald Trump. The precise terms of the deal were not immediately known. Sharif said the pact called for "the immediate and permanent termination of military operations on all fronts, including in Lebanon".

Oil slips 4% as US, Iran reach peace deal to reopen Strait of Hormuz: (Economy: Positive)

Oil prices slipped to their lowest since March on Monday after US President Donald Trump and Iran's deputy foreign minister said they had reached an initial deal to end the war and to resume traffic through the Strait of Hormuz. Brent crude futures fell \$3.58, or 4.10%, to \$83.75 a barrel by 0004 GMT and US West Texas Intermediate was at \$80.87, down \$4.01, or 4.72%.

Petrol price cut by Rs4, diesel by Rs2: (Economy: Positive)

The government on Friday reduced the prices of diesel and petrol by Rs2 and Rs4 per litre, respectively, with immediate effect for the week ending June 19, owing to changes in global oil prices over the past week. Accordingly, the ex-depot price of high-speed diesel (HSD) was fixed at Rs378.78 per litre, down from Rs380.78. The government also made some upward adjustments to the tax rate on diesel. The price of diesel has fallen significantly from its peak of Rs520.35 per litre recorded on 10 April. HSD is considered the most inflationary fuel due to its extensive use in freight transportation.

Weekly inflation up 0.16pc: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

The Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI)-based weekly inflation increased by 0.16 per cent during the week ended on June 11, 2026 for the combined consumption group, the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS) reported on Friday. According to PBS data, SPI for the week under review declined to 356.11 points as compared to 355.55 points recorded in the previous week. On a year-on-year (YoY) basis, the SPI increased by 15.06 per cent.

Policy rate hike unlikely in final FY26 review: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The grounds for an increase in the policy rate have largely disappeared ahead of the State Bank of Pakistan's (SBP) upcoming monetary policy announcement, as global oil prices have either remained stable or eased despite heightened tensions in the Gulf, market participants said. The increase was attributed to geopolitical tensions following the conflict in April, which pushed oil prices higher and disrupted global supply chains.

Super tax on up to Rs500m income abolished: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Finance Bill 2026 has abolished super tax on persons having income of up to Rs. 500 million. The rate has been reduced from 10 percent to 8 percent for persons having income of more than Rs. 500 million. However, these concessions do not apply to banking, exploration and production sector and fertilizer sectors. It is pertinent to note that the aforesaid concessions and relief measures are not applicable to the banking sector, the Exploration and Production (ENP) sector and the fertilizer sector.

18% sales tax abolition on shipping hailed as major boost: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The government has abolished the 18% sales tax on the shipping industry in the 2026-27 budget. Federal Minister for Maritime Affairs Muhammad Junaid Anwar Chaudhry hailed it as a major boost for the maritime and logistics sectors, according to a press release issued. He said the decision addressed a long-standing demand from industry stakeholders and would significantly improve the competitiveness of Pakistan's maritime services.

Petroleum levy emerges as biggest non-tax revenue source in FY27: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

The government is projecting Rs1.677 trillion in collections from the petroleum levy in FY2026-27, cementing its position as the single largest contributor to non-tax revenues and highlighting the growing reliance on fuel-related charges to support the federal budget. According to budget documents, petroleum levy receipts are expected to rise from a revised estimate of Rs1.498 trillion in the outgoing fiscal year to Rs1.677 trillion in FY2025-26, accounting for nearly one-third of the government's projected Rs5.34 trillion in total non-tax revenue.

Pakistan awards 24 offshore blocks, attracts \$1bn investment: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan has achieved notable progress in the exploration and development of its oil and gas resources during FY2025-26, with investment in the exploration and production (E&P) sector expected to surpass \$1 billion, Finance Minister Senator Muhammad Aurangzeb said while presenting the Federal Budget 2026-27 in the National Assembly on Friday. Highlighting developments in the energy sector, the finance minister said Pakistan successfully awarded 24 offshore exploration blocks to national and international exploration and production companies, marking the first such large-scale offshore licensing initiative in nearly two decades.
