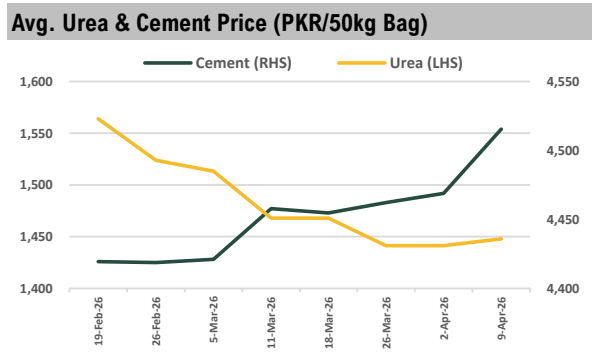

**Oil prices fall as hopes for US-Iran deal outweigh supply disruption concerns:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Oil prices fell in early trade on Thursday as hopes for easing US-Iran tensions, following reports that Iran could allow ships to pass through around the Strait of Hormuz, outweighed concerns over ongoing supply disruptions. Brent crude futures dropped 44 cents, or 0.5%, to \$94.49 a barrel at 0021 GMT. US West Texas Intermediate crude futures was down 70 cents, or 0.8%, at \$90.59 a barrel.

**Islamabad set to host first-ever EU-Pakistan Business Forum:** (Economy: Positive)

With the European Union's €400 billion Global Gateway investment programme in focus, Islamabad is set to host the bloc's first-ever high-level EU-Pakistan Business Forum later this month — a move that signals a shift from trade-driven ties to an investment-led partnership aimed at repositioning Pakistan in evolving global supply chains. Scheduled for April 28–29 in Islamabad, the forum will bring together policymakers, European and Pakistani business leaders, investors, and financial institutions at what officials describe as a “pivotal moment” in bilateral economic engagement.

**Saudi Arabia pledges \$3bn, extends \$5bn facility till 2028:** (Economy: Positive)

Saudi Arabia has committed an additional \$3 billion in deposits for Pakistan and extended its existing \$5bn facility for three years, Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb announced in Washington. Briefing journalists at the Pakistan Embassy on Tuesday evening, Mr Aurangzeb said the Saudi support provides a major boost to the country's external financing position. The minister, who is in Washington to attend the IMF-World Bank Spring Meetings, said the fresh \$3bn deposit would be disbursed in the coming week.

**Govt weighs spot LNG as Iran war hits supply, ramps up domestic oil and gas:**

(Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Minister for Petroleum Ali Pervaiz Malik said on Wednesday that the government is considering buying liquefied natural gas (LNG) on the spot market to offset supply disruptions caused by the Iran war, but would favour government-to-government deals to avoid paying steep premiums. Spot LNG cargoes have surged to \$20 to \$30 per mmBtu amid the Middle East conflict, Malik told Reuters.

**IMF projects 0.5pc fall in govt's primary balance:** (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has projected a decline of 0.5 percent in the government's primary balance for the next fiscal year, and projected it at 2 percent against 2.5 percent in 2026 and 2.4 percent in 2025. According to the IMF report “Fiscal Monitor, fiscal policy under pressure: higher debt, rising risks,” a decline of 2.1 percent in Pakistan's government net debt is projected, decreasing from 66.5 percent of GDP in 2025 to 64.4 percent in 2026 and 62.1 percent in fiscal year 2027.

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has advised the gradual elimination of burdensome fuel subsidies, the tackling of contingent liabilities, and the expansion of the tax base to ensure credible medium-term fiscal sustainability.

**Massive outages as deficit hits 6,500MW:** (Economy: Negative)

The country faces a worsening electricity crisis, with the overall power shortfall reaching 6,500 megawatts (MW). This leads to prolonged load shedding across multiple regions and growing public frustration. According to sources, total electricity demand has surged to around 22,000MW, while generation remains limited to 15,400MW. Sources said generation from gas-based power plants declined due to fuel shortages, contributing to reduced output.

**Special subsidy for farmers announced:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The federal government on Wednesday announced a special subsidy programme for farmers to mitigate the adverse impact of the global energy crisis. Eligible farmers can register for three easy subsidy packages through the Pakistan Asaan Khidmat application. Meanwhile, a senior official told Dawn that the government would provide a subsidy of Rs1,500 per acre to farmers owning less than 12 acres of land.

**Gas firms seek steep increases:** (Economy: Neutral to Negative) (SSGC, SNGP: Positive)

Sui Northern Gas Pipeline Ltd (SNGPL) and Sui Southern Gas Company Ltd (SSGCL) have sought about 21 and 121 per cent increases in the prescribed gas prices, respectively, to meet their revenue requirements for 2026-27. The SSGCL has also sought previous years' "unrecovered shortfalls" of over Rs545 billion, which makes its accumulated demand for an increase in the prescribed price a massive 286pc, according to a summary of petitions finalised by the Oil & Gas Regulatory Authority.

**Biggest well begins oil, gas production:** (Economy: Positive) (OGDC: Positive)

The Oil and Gas Development Company Ltd (OGDCL) on Wednesday began commercial production from the highest-ever oil and gas discovery from a single well in the country's history. Baragzai X-01 (Slant) exploratory well in the Nashpa Block, Kohat district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, is now the highest-producing well and contributes approximately 10pc of OGDCL's total crude oil production. After Wednesday's injection of 5,300 barrels of oil per day (bps), 17 million standard cubic feet per day (mmscfd) of gas, and 15 tonnes per day of liquefied petroleum gas, the cumulative production from the well has reached 15,000bpd and 45 mmscfd of gas.
