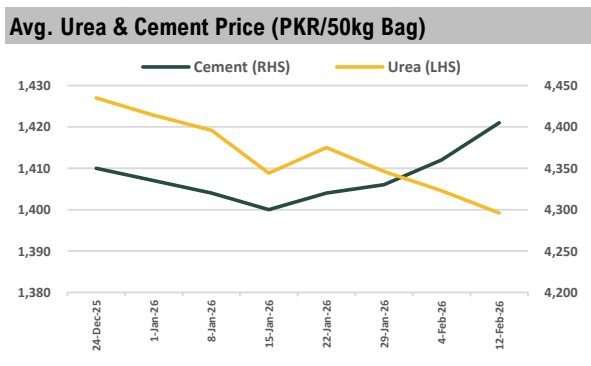

IMF review mission arrives on 25th: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

An IMF review mission is scheduled to arrive on February 25 for a two-week stay, during which officials will assess economic performance from July to December 2025, alongside progress on agreed benchmarks covering taxation, energy reforms, monetary policy and foreign exchange reserves. While authorities met targets for the primary budget surplus and provincial cash balances, the federal tax goal fell short by Rs329 billion. The Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) collected Rs6,161 billion over six months, according to official figures.

IMF says discussing power tariff tweaks with Pakistan: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The International Monetary Fund is discussing proposed electricity tariff revisions with Pakistan authorities, the fund told Reuters, adding that the burden of the revisions should not fall on middle- or lower income households. "The ongoing discussions with the authorities will assess whether the proposed tariff revisions are consistent with these commitments and evaluate their potential impact on macroeconomic stability, including inflation," it said in its statement. PM to announce construction relief plan: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

He said the government was following an export-led policy and would soon announce relief measures for the construction sector. "The prime minister is expected to make a formal announcement." Federal Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb has declared that after achieving economic stability, the next priority is industrialisation to ensure sustainable economic growth. The government is also reviewing support measures for the textile sector and is considering reducing tax rates for the property sector.

25pc US tariff threat: Govt adopts cautious approach to trade with Iran: (Economy: Neutral)

The government has reportedly decided to adopt a cautious approach toward trade with Iran following the United States' announcement of a potential 25 percent tariff on countries doing business with Tehran. The United States remains Pakistan's largest single-country export destination, accounting for 18 percent of total exports—or approximately \$5.8 billion—during FY2024-25, according to FBR data.

China firm eyes Port Qasim Sea-to-Steel project: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

A Chinese industrial group is to submit an unsolicited feasibility study for a proposed Integrated Maritime Industrial Complex (IMIC) at Port Qasim. The move marks a potential step toward developing ship recycling, port upgrades and an integrated steel mill at the country's second-largest seaport. The IMIC comprises three core components, including the revival and upgrading of the Iron Ore and Coal Berth (IOCB) jetty. The facility is planned to handle ship recycling and repair operations, with recyclable scrap to be used as feedstock for reviving a steel mill within the complex. The proposed project, described as a "Sea-to-Steel Green Maritime Industrial Corridor," seeks to integrate ship recycling with domestic steel production in a bid to reduce reliance on imported raw materials.

Pakistan's bonds draw biggest foreign inflows in 19 months: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan drew the biggest monthly net foreign inflows into its sovereign bonds since June 2024, signalling improving investor sentiment for the market as its currency strengthens, according to Bloomberg. Net inflows in January reached \$176 million, compared with withdrawals of \$50 million a year ago, according to central bank data compiled by Bloomberg. Short-term bonds with a duration of one year or less drew 85 per cent of these flows.

Loan repayment cuts FX to \$15.5b: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Pakistan has repaid a \$700 million Chinese commercial loan this week, temporarily reducing foreign exchange reserves to \$15.5 billion, as it now faces a decision on whether to return bilateral cash deposit loans or seek their extension, a move that may limit its policy choices. The sources said another \$1 billion loan from the China Development Bank is maturing in June this year, which the government may repay ahead of schedule in the hope of securing refinancing before the close of the current financial year.

Oil drifts ahead of US-Iran nuclear talks: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Oil prices traded sideways on Monday ahead of talks between Washington and Tehran, with concerns about Iran-US tensions disrupting oil flows keeping a floor under prices, while OPEC+ leans in favour of resuming output hikes from April. Brent crude futures edged down 3 cents to \$67.72 a barrel by 0156 GMT after closing 23 cents higher on Friday. US West Texas Intermediate crude was at \$62.86 a barrel, down 3 cents.

Petrol up by Rs5, diesel by Rs7.32 per litre: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

According to a notification issued by the Petroleum Division, the price of petrol (motor spirit) has been increased by Rs5 per litre to Rs258.17, while high-speed diesel (HSD) has gone up by Rs7.32 per litre to Rs275.70, effective immediately from Feb 16. The hike follows recommendations by the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) after the government's routine fortnightly fuel price review.

OGRA raises RLNG prices by up to 0.59%: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Pakistan's oil and gas regulator has raised re-gasified liquefied natural gas (RLNG) prices by up to 0.59% for February 2026, citing a marginal increase in terminal charges. The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) announced its decision on Friday, increasing RLNG rates for both Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Ltd (SNGPL) and Sui Southern Gas Company Ltd (SSGCL). The changes reflect an increase of up to \$0.0605 per million British thermal units (MMBtu) across transmission and distribution costs.

The government has accelerated efforts to privatise three major power distribution companies (discos) — Islamabad Electric Supply Company (IESCO), Gujranwala Electric Power Company (GEPCO) and Faisalabad Electric Supply Company (FESCO) — with officials confident that the divestment process will be completed in the second half of the current calendar year.

PIA set to become fully private as consortium to buy remaining 25pc stake: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Arif Habib Group consortium will acquire the remaining 25 percent stake in Pakistan International Airlines (PIA), a move that will grant it full ownership of the national flag carrier. According to him, the formal decision is expected in April, after which the payment will be completed within 12 months. Under the agreement finalised in January, a 12-month period has been allowed for the transfer of funds, making the transaction financially viable.

Clover Pakistan plans 10-for-1 share split: (Economy: Neutral) (CLOV: Positive)

The Board of Directors of Clover Pakistan Limited (PSX: CLOV) has approved a proposal to subdivide the company's shares in a move aimed at improving affordability and liquidity for investors, according to a disclosure submitted to the Pakistan Stock Exchange. The board, in its meeting held on February 13, recommended a 10-for-1 stock split, reducing the face value of each ordinary share from Rs10 to Rs1. Eligible shareholders will receive 10 shares for every 1 share held as of the record date to be announced after the EOGM.
