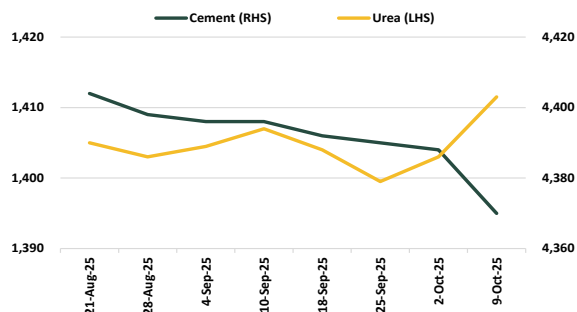

Aurangzeb meets Saudi finance minister, briefs him on ongoing privatisation of PIA and key airports: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb met his Saudi counterpart on the third day of his ongoing US visit, the finance ministry said on Thursday, adding that the former briefed the latter about the privatisation process of the Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) and key airports. The meeting was held on the sidelines of the plenary meetings of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank (WB) in Washington, D.C., where Aurangzeb arrived on Sunday on a six-day trip.

IMF warns of revenue, pension pressures: (Economy: Negative)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has forecast a gradual improvement in Pakistan's fiscal indicators over the next five years, including a lower fiscal deficit and a reduced debt-to-GDP ratio. However, it has also warned of persistent revenue shortfalls and rising pension and health expenditures. In its Fiscal Monitor 2025, released on the sidelines of the IMF-World Bank annual meetings, the estimate for Pakistan's fiscal deficit or the current financial year is 4.1 per cent of GDP, down from 5.3pc last year but slightly higher than the government's budget target of 3.9pc.

Following the rejection of proposals to increase tax rates on fertilizer and pesticides, Pakistan and the International Monetary Fund (IMF) are considering alternative options — raising taxes on rooftop solar panels, internet services and other sectors — as contingency measures in case of a revenue shortfall.

Govt estimates floods caused Rs822bn losses: (Economy: Negative)

Pakistan's economy has suffered estimated losses of Rs822 billion due to the recent floods that affected more than 6.5 million people across 70 districts, according to official assessments. The initial damage estimates have been revised upwards from Rs744 billion to the current Rs822 billion, with the agriculture and infrastructure sectors emerging as the most severely impacted.

SBP warns floods may weigh on growth: (Economy: Negative)

Pakistan's central bank said on Thursday that the country's macroeconomic conditions were stable at the start of fiscal year 2026, but it warned that flood-induced damages to agriculture and infrastructure pose risks to the overall economic outlook. The losses caused by the flood are expected to pose upside risks to the projections for both twin deficits and the inflation outlook, while presenting downside risks for growth.

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Pakistan's revised trade deficit narrows to \$3.4bn in September: (Economy: Negative)

Pakistan's revised trade deficit for September 2025 stood at \$3.4 billion, equivalent to Rs960.6bn, according to provisional figures released by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS). The trade gap widened compared to the previous month, as a rise in imports outpaced moderate export growth. On a cumulative basis, the July–September FY2025–26 trade deficit reached \$9.43bn (Rs2.67 trillion). Exports from Pakistan during September 2025 amounted to Rs704bn (\$2.5bn), up 3.0% MoM from Rs683.2bn (\$2.42bn) in August 2025.

Macroeconomic stability in FY25: SBP report cites IMF's EFF, other reasons: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) Thursday said a prudent monetary policy stance and continued fiscal consolidation strengthened macroeconomic stability in FY25. Moreover, favourable global commodity prices and IMF's Extended Fund Facility (EFF) further supported improvement in overall macroeconomic conditions. According to the Report, in FY25, the real GDP growth edged higher, driven by services sector and a recovery in overall industrial activities. This was despite decline in the production of important crops and a contraction in large-scale manufacturing. In tandem with the expansion in economic activity, imports also increased.

K-Electric denies any confirmed Saudi deal for shareholder's stake sale: (Economy: Neutral) (KEL: Neutral to Negative)

K-Electric Limited (KE) on Thursday clarified that it has not received any confirmation from its indirect shareholder, KES Power Limited (KESP), regarding reports of a potential sale of KESP's interest to a Saudi investor, after media reports suggested such a transaction was under discussion. In a disclosure submitted to the Pakistan Stock Exchange (PSX) and Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP), KE said it had sought verification from KESP — its majority shareholder — after news surfaced that one of KESP's shareholders had signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with a Saudi investor for a possible stake sale.
