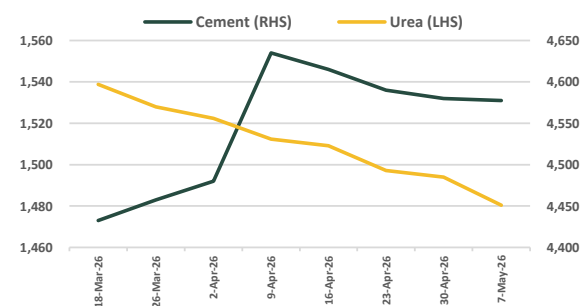

IMF sets Rs17.1tr federal revenue target for 2026-27: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

With Rs430 billion in new budgetary measures and an 18 per cent higher petroleum levy, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) has targeted Pakistan's federal revenues at Rs17.145 trillion for 2026-27, along with a series of administrative and policy measures committed by the government for the federal and provincial budgets to be passed by the parliament. In its staff report on completion of third review of \$7bn Extended Fund Facility (EFF) and second review of \$1.4bn Resilience and Sustainability Facility (RSF), the fund has projected total federal revenues for FY27 at Rs17.144tr — over Rs2.03tr higher than the current fiscal year, up 13.5pc.

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has said that Government Finance Statistics (GFS) compiled by the Finance Division remain subject to shortcomings that undermine transparency, including a persistent statistical discrepancy between above and below-the-line measures of the fiscal deficit. The Fund's latest report stressed that improvements to the macroeconomic statistics are ongoing but should be accompanied by enhanced transparency and Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS).

IMF cuts power subsidy volume to 0.6pc of GDP: Reduction in CD flow: (Economy: Neutral)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has slashed the volume of power subsidy from 0.7 of GDP to 0.6 per cent of GDP for FY 2026-27 due to reduction in flow of Circular Debt, owing to ongoing improvements in operational efficiency and performance. A large tariff reduction for industrial consumers in February maintained system cost-recovery by unwinding industrial consumers' cross-subsidy to residential consumers, which was balanced out by increasing or introducing fixed charges on residential consumers, including some protected consumers.

IMF questions Pakistan's Rs3.4tr gas circular debt plan, seeks clarifications: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has raised concerns over Pakistan's proposed gas circular debt management plan, questioning key measures including a proposed petroleum levy and the use of state-owned company dividends to retire liabilities, officials familiar with the discussions said. According to senior Energy ministry officials, the IMF representatives carefully reviewed the presentation made by the Petroleum Division but flagged concerns that imposing a new levy on petrol and diesel could increase fuel prices and add inflationary pressure on consumers. The Fund also questioned whether diverting dividends from public-sector energy companies toward debt retirement aligns with standard corporate practices.

Second LNG vessel from Qatar arrives in Pakistan: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan on Friday received its second liquefied natural gas (LNG) cargo from Qatar within three days as the government intensified efforts to avert worsening power shortages amid regional supply disruptions triggered by the US-Israel conflict with Iran. The government is now in contact with Qatari authorities to secure two additional LNG cargoes after four Pakistan-bound shipments became stranded because of disruptions linked to the US-Israel military action against Iran earlier this year.
