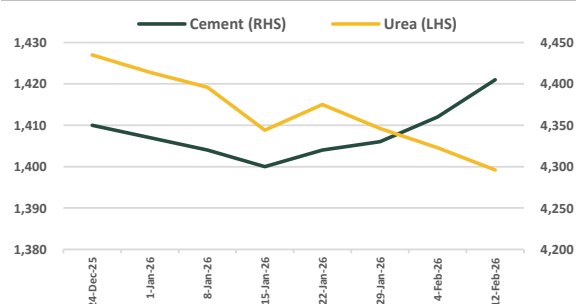

Pakistan readies 15-point action plan ahead of IMF review mission: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Just ahead of the upcoming review mission of IMF, Pakistan has prepared a 15-point action plan in response to the Governance and Diagnostic Assessment Report (GCD), including identifying the top 10 high-risk federal agencies with corruption vulnerabilities and macro-critical exposures. The action plan envisages reduction in the backlog of economic disputes by developing and publishing the methodology to be used to assess the performance of courts and judges (Year 1), and publishing the first performance report covering all Administrative Tribunals and Special Courts involved in economic and commercial matters (Year 2).

Govt eyes over \$300m from spectrum sale: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The government is likely to receive between \$300 and \$ 700 million from the upcoming spectrum auction scheduled for March 10. The Pakistan Telecommunication Authority (PTA) on Wednesday apprised the media that no changes are likely to be made in the auction schedule. The regulator expects that the auction will eventually help increase telcos' earnings.

Oil prices rise 3pc on US-Iran tensions: (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices rose by more than 3 per cent on Wednesday as traders priced in potential supply disruptions amid concerns of conflict between the United States and Iran, and after talks between Ukraine and Russia in Geneva ended without a breakthrough. Brent crude oil futures were up \$2.38, or 3.53pc, at \$69.80 a barrel at 12:09pm EDT, while US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures gained \$2.39, or 3.83pc, to \$64.72. Both contracts fell to two-week lows on Tuesday.

Incremental consumption package: Industry, PD lock horns over financial impact: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

The country's industry and the Power Division have locked horns over the financial impact of the incremental consumption package on the overall electricity tariff, with both sides presenting conflicting claims about whether the relief measure led to new demand or merely shifted industrial load from captive generation to the national grid. The proposed adjustment carries an impact of 43 paise per unit (Rs 10.762 billion), replacing the 33 paise per unit adjustment of the first quarter of the current fiscal year.

Power firms seek Rs1.78 more for January: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

After a period of relative stability, power companies have sought additional fuel cost charges of over Rs1.78 per unit from consumers across the country in March bills, as demand appeared to pick up and power generators returned to furnace oil. Electricity consumption was reported to be around 12pc higher than the same month last year and 8pc higher than December 2025.

Apple to manufacture iPhones in Pakistan: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

American tech giant Apple is set to start manufacturing iPhones in Pakistan after the government has agreed to offer incentives in the proposed Mobile and Electronics Manufacturing Framework. Apple has also agreed to refurbish iPhones in Pakistan for re-export under the new framework. The government expects \$100 million from the re-export of refurbished iPhones in the first year. Apple management has asked for the provision of land at discounted rates, 8% performance incentive and plans to repair two to three-year-old iPhones.

FDI plunges 41pc to \$981m: (Economy: Negative)

Foreign direct investment (FDI) plunged year-on-year by 41 per cent in the first seven months of 2025-26. Data issued by the State Bank on Wednesday showed that the confidence of foreign investors further declined compared to the previous year, as their investment during July-January FY26 fell to \$981 million from \$1.660 billion in the same period of the previous fiscal year.

IT exports surge 19pc: (Economy: Positive) (Tech: Positive)

Pakistan recorded monthly IT exports of \$374 million in January, up 19 per cent year-on-year (YoY) basis but down 14pc month on month (MoM). This takes 7MFY26 to \$2.6 billion, reflecting a 20pc YoY growth. While the government has set a target of \$5bn for FY26, the brokerage house expects IT exports to grow by 18-20pc during the year to \$4.5bn versus FY25 exports of \$3.8bn.

RDA inflows hit \$11.9bn as of January: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan received inflows of \$11.923 billion under the Roshan Digital Account (RDA) as of January 2026, data from the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) showed on Wednesday. In January, the amount of funds received through RDA increased to \$216 million, up from \$213 million in the previous month. Net inflows under the RDA amounted to \$145 million in January, compared to a six-month average of \$175 million and an overall average of \$153 million since its launch in September 2020.
