

Pakistan, Afghanistan announce pause in fighting for Eid: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

As Pakistan and Afghanistan said Wednesday they were pausing their military operations against each other for Eidul Fitr, Pakistani's military spokesperson Lt Gen Ahmed Sharif Chaudhry said that militant elements were being harboured in government facilities in Afghanistan under Taliban patronage.

ADB unveils \$10bn five-year financing plan: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) is expected to extend about \$10 billion in financing to Pakistan over the next five years under its Country Partnership Strategy 2026-30 (CPS 2026-30), launched on Wednesday. "The five-year strategy will focus on three pathways: enabling private sector development, advancing inclusion and empowerment, and enhancing resilience and sustainability," it said.

Oil prices jump 5pc as Iran warns to attack ME energy facilities: (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices rose more than 5 percent on Wednesday after Iran's Revolutionary Guards threatened to attack several energy facilities across the Middle East in retaliation, heightening the risk of further disruptions to energy supplies in the region. Brent futures rose USD5.26, or 5 percent to USD108.66 a barrel at 1105 a.m. ET (1505 GMT) on Wednesday, having risen to as high as USD109.95 earlier in the session, while US West Texas Intermediate crude gained USD2.44, or 2.54 percent, to USD98.65. WTI also hit its widest discount to Brent since May 2019 on fears of a protracted conflict.

Power bills to rise Rs1.64/unit in April: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Electricity consumers could see higher power bills as early as April after utilities asked the country's energy regulator Monday to approve an additional charge of Rs1.64 per unit to recover fuel costs that ran significantly above what customers were billed in February 2026. Total power generation in February reached 7,696 gigawatt-hours (GWh) at a cost of Rs62.75 billion, or roughly Rs8.15 per unit.

Govt body reviews energy situation: Diesel stocks provide about 24-day cover: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Amid global market volatility, the Cabinet Committee to Monitor Petrol Prices affirmed stable fuel supplies while directing urgent coordination with the State Bank of Pakistan and other banks, including temporary enhancements and consortium-based financing where required, to ease operational challenges arising from the increased size of Letters of Credit (LCs) and safeguard uninterrupted imports.

The government is considering keeping petrol and high-speed diesel (HSD) prices unchanged until March 31, despite rising global oil prices, sources told The News on Wednesday. According to sources, the minister said the government is making efforts to secure additional cargoes of crude oil and refined products, including the possibility of imports from Russia to keep domestic refineries operational.

'MT Karachi' first non-Iranian tanker passing thru Hormuz: (Economy: Positive)

The Pakistani oil tanker, MT Karachi, has become the first non-Iranian commercial vessel to successfully navigate the Strait of Hormuz with active tracking since the ongoing regional conflict put the world's most critical oil chokepoint to a complete halt. However, the voyage of MT Karachi, with active tracking, distinguished it from dozens of so-called "dark ships" that have crossed the strait with disabled tracking to evade detection since the conflict began on February 28. However, the MT Karachi kept its tracking system fully active throughout the crossing, confirmed by Marine Traffic.
