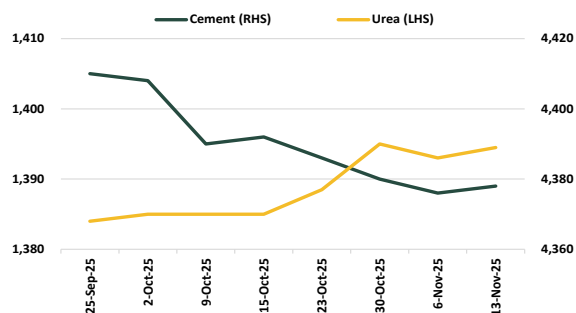

Structural reforms under sharper focus, Aurangzeb tells Dialog delegation: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Federal Minister for Finance and Revenue, Muhammad Aurangzeb, on Tuesday stressed the government's focus on structural reforms, including taxation, energy sector restructuring, and privatisation of state-owned enterprises, governance reforms, and federal expenditure rationalisation. Proper bunkering ensures safe, efficient and environmentally compliant refueling, enabling smooth maritime transport and global shipping operations.

Vitol, Cnergyico make Pakistan's biggest single delivery of marine fuel: (Economy: Positive)

Vitol and Cnergyico, Pakistan's largest oil refiner, have delivered the country's biggest single shipment of very low sulphur fuel oil for ship refuelling, the global trading firm said in a statement late Monday. The move will enable large vessels refuelling in Pakistan to now sail longer routes from east to west without needing to stop elsewhere, while also giving Pakistan a stronger local supply of environmentally compliant marine fuel.

Standard Chartered, IFC expand \$400m facility to support exporters: (Economy: Positive)

Standard Chartered Bank Pakistan and the International Finance Corporation (IFC), a member of the World Bank Group, have agreed to a \$400 million Risk-Participation Facility to support short-term trade and working capital financing for major Pakistani exporters and corporates. The facility, formalized in September 2025, doubles the size of a previous \$200 million arrangement established in December 2022. The expanded facility aims to boost foreign exchange inflows and strengthen Pakistan's export-driven sectors by improving access to trade finance, supply chain financing, and sustainable finance products.

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Jul-Oct trade deficit jumps 39pc to USD12.7bn YoY: (Economy: Negative)

Negative growth in all major exportable categories apart from textile and an upsurge in petroleum imports ballooned the trade deficit to USD12.7 billion, showing an increase of 39 percent in the July-October period of 2025-26. According to an advance release on external trade statistics issued by the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, on a year-on-year (YoY) basis, exports declined by 4 percent to USD10.4 billion in the first four months of FY26. Whereas the imports increased by 15.5 percent in the same corresponding period of FY26 to 12.7 billion.

Country witnessing rise in business confidence: SECP: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan is witnessing a significant rise in business confidence and investment activity, supported by the effective facilitation and strategic direction of the Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC), according to new data released by the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) on Tuesday. SECP reported that 14,802 new companies were registered in the first four months of the current financial year, marking a strong upward trajectory in business formation. With the latest additions, the total number of registered companies in Pakistan has reached 272,918, reflecting expanding economic activity across sectors.

Textile exports dip in October: (Economy: Negative) (Textile: Negative)

Pakistan's textile exports edged down in October 2025, slipping 0.57 percent to \$1.616 billion, even as the sector showed a modest rebound from the previous month, official data showed Tuesday. The month-on-month improvement, a 2.78 percent rise from September's \$1.57 billion, offered some relief to exporters, but the year-on-year picture remained weak. The Pakistan Bureau of Statistics said key textile categories, including knitwear, towels, cotton cloth and cotton yarn, all posted declines compared with last year.

Power firms seek to refund Rs6.3bn for October usage: (Economy: Neutral)

With a 3.5 per cent decrease in power consumption in October over last year, the Central Power Purchasing Agency (CPPA) has sought around 65 paise per unit negative fuel cost adjustment (FCA) for consumers across the country in December bills as almost 75 per cent of the generation came from cheaper domestic, predominantly zero-cost fuel sources. RLNG gets costlier for third time in November: (Economy: Negative)

On top of about a 4.4 per cent increase over the past two months, the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) on Tuesday notified up to 2pc further increase in the price of Regasified Liquefied Natural Gas (RLNG) for sales at the distribution stage by the two Sui gas companies for November, mainly because of higher system losses. This was despite the fact that the average LNG price delivered at ship (DES) in November was about \$0.75 per unit (million British thermal unit) lower than in October, as the utilities' losses went up.

The Competition Appellate Tribunal, Islamabad has remanded the Al-Ghazi Tractors Limited case back to the Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP) for fresh proceedings from the stage of the show cause notice. During the hearing, the appellant relied on a report of the Agricultural Mechanization Research Institute (AMRI), Punjab, which had been cited in its defence, said a press release issued. The Tribunal directed that before proceeding further, CCP shall issue a notice to AMRI and confront the institute with the report placed on record, along with the conclusions drawn by the appellant regarding its contents.
