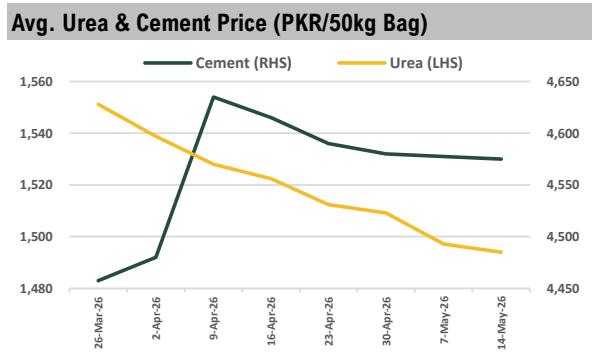

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) mission visiting Pakistan has concluded talks with authorities focusing on economic developments, fiscal plans for the next financial year, and progress on reforms under the country's IMF-supported programmes, the international money lender said in a statement issued early on Thursday.

**Pakistan secures \$1.2bn oil facility from KSA:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan has availed itself of \$1.2 billion oil facility from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA), as the country received \$100 million per month from May 2025 to April 2026. "Saudi Fund for Development (SFD) provided an oil facility of \$1.2 billion from May 2025 till April 2026. The SFD provided \$100 million per month basis. The last tranche of this oil facility has just been availed in April 2026," Federal Minister for Economic Affairs Ahad Cheema said when contacted for comments on Wednesday.
