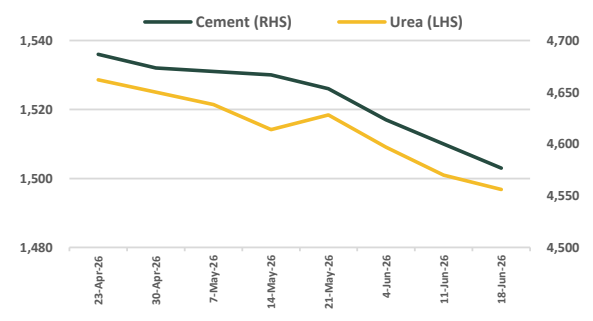

**Pakistan-Qatar joint statement: Iran, US agree to reach final deal within 60 days:** (Economy: Positive)

Iran and the United States have agreed on a roadmap to reach a final deal within 60 days, laying the foundation for the immediate commencement of further technical talks, according to a joint statement issued simultaneously by the Pakistani and Qatari foreign ministries. The parties also agreed to establish a de-confliction cell between the parties and the Lebanese Republic, facilitated by the Mediators, to ensure adherence to the termination of military operations in Lebanon as per the MoU. Technical talks will continue for the remainder of the week at the Burgenstock resort on all issues. Building on the MoU, the parties have also agreed to the establishment of a High Level Committee, which will provide political oversight on the mediation.

**Iran's president due today:** (Economy: Positive)

Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian will arrive in Pakistan on today (Tuesday) following talks between Tehran and Washington in Switzerland, which were mediated by Islamabad. key priorities on agenda include expressing gratitude to Pakistani Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif for Islamabad's mediation efforts between Iran and the United States. Additionally, the visit aims to sustain high-level bilateral consultations, advance ongoing cooperation, and review previously established economic agreements between the two nations. Pakistan, while welcoming the arrival of President Pezeshkian to Islamabad on a state visit, asserted that this forthcoming visit reflects the shared commitment of Pakistan and Iran to further deepen their historic and cultural ties and underscores their common aspiration for peace, stability and sustainable progress in the region. Pezeshkian visits Pakistan on the invitation of Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, and will be accompanied by a high-level delegation, including ministers and other high-ranking officials.

**US-Iran talks: PM says satisfied with successful conclusion:** (Economy: Positive)

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif said on Monday that Pakistan remains committed to playing what he described as an "honest and sincere" role in promoting dialogue, following a high-level meeting between the US and Iran held in Switzerland under the Islamabad Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). In his first comments after the talks concluded in Burgenstock, Switzerland, the prime minister said he was satisfied with what he called the "successful conclusion" of the engagement. He said the discussions took place in a "positive and constructive atmosphere" and produced "encouraging progress", including agreement on a proposed roadmap towards a final deal within 60 days, the formation of a high-level political oversight committee, and the launch of further technical-level negotiations. He also expressed gratitude to "brotherly and friendly countries" for their support in facilitating the process, singling out Qatar for its "critical support" in helping create conditions for the talks to proceed.

## **BUDGET 2026-27 : NA panel proposes 30 major changes to Finance Bill: (Economy: Positive)**

The National Assembly Standing Committee on Finance approved the Finance Bill 2026 on Monday after making around 30 major amendments that reshaped key tax provisions through revisions to rates, enforcement mechanisms, deletions and new insertions. The amended bill will now be presented before the National Assembly for final approval, where a clause-by-clause vote will determine its passage. The Senate committee had earlier submitted 123 recommendations on the bill. The standing committee finalised its report earlier in the day, which will now be placed before the National Assembly for adoption ahead of the final budget vote. The committee proposed an instalment-based tax on imported mobile phones via the Pakistan Telecommunication Authority's device system, alongside easing penalty structures, expanding exemptions, reducing tax rates for wholesalers, and revising the import regime for electric vehicles. Several proposed measures were dropped, including changes linked to the petroleum levy, while new enforcement tools were added to strengthen compliance. These include digital production monitoring, faceless tax assessments and an algorithm-based settlement mechanism intended to resolve disputes without direct interaction between taxpayers and officials. In customs laws, the committee introduced tighter administrative controls requiring board-level decisions to obtain ministerial approval and mandating competitive procurement under public procurement rules. It also reduced the limitation period from 10 years to 5 years and introduced safeguards requiring that affected parties be heard before orders are issued, except in urgent cases involving risk of asset dissipation.

## **Govt withdraws fuel subsidy for bikers, farmers, transporters: (Economy: Negative)**

The federal government has decided to discontinue the fuel subsidy scheme for motorcyclists, small farmers, and public and goods transport operators, citing a significant decline in international oil prices and the relief already provided through reduced petroleum rates. The decision was taken during the seventh meeting of the National Steering Committee on Fuel Subsidy, chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Ishaq Dar on Monday. According to an official statement, the committee reviewed the implementation of the subsidy programme across the provinces, as well as in Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir. Members noted that global fuel prices had dropped considerably in recent months and that the government had already passed on the benefit to consumers through substantial reductions in petroleum product prices.

## **Loads inks non-binding MOU with Xinhuida to explore copper ventures: (Economy: Positive) (LOADS: Positive)**

Loads Limited (PSX: LOADS) has entered into a non-binding Memorandum of Understanding with Anhui Xinhuida New Material Technology Co., Ltd., a China-based company engaged in recycling, processing, manufacturing and trading of copper, advanced copper materials and technology-intensive industrial products. Xinhuida operates an integrated platform covering recycled copper rods, copper processing, copper products, power and communication cables, EV wiring systems, digital energy harnesses, PV connectors, semiconductor-related components and other advanced copper-based materials and products. The MOU provides a framework to explore potential cooperation in the copper sector in Pakistan and international markets, including copper trading, processing, manufacturing, exports, strategic investments, technology transfer, supply chain integration and related commercial opportunities. Under the understanding, both parties intend to initially pursue copper trading and supply chain opportunities while evaluating a potential joint venture in Pakistan involving investment in copper, advanced copper materials, value-added products and technology-intensive industrial businesses. The scope also includes possible acquisition opportunities in the copper manufacturing sector in Pakistan to support expansion and export-oriented growth. The collaboration may further extend to the establishment of new manufacturing facilities, technology transfer, development of export-oriented operations, and introduction of advanced copper materials, components, wiring solutions and energy infrastructure products for domestic and international markets. All potential arrangements, including any joint venture or acquisition, remain subject to due diligence, negotiation of definitive agreements and regulatory approvals, with no binding obligation on either party except customary confidentiality undertakings.
