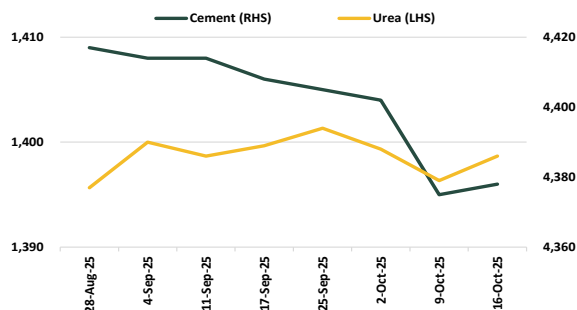

Aurangzeb touts macro gains post-IMF meetings: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb stated on Wednesday that the country's foreign exchange reserves are presently sufficient to cover approximately two and a half months of imports, with projections indicating this could increase to three months by the close of the current fiscal year. The minister highlighted that Pakistan continues to consolidate its gains on the macroeconomic stability front. The minister went on to claim that the currency remained stable and inflation is expected to remain within the range of 5 to 7 per cent for the ongoing fiscal year, supported by a downward trend in the policy rate.

Pakistan expects to receive USD1.2 billion from the IMF and achieve 3.5percent economic growth this fiscal year, Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb said, citing progress in reforms and global recognition of the country's economic stability.

FinMin promises PIA sale, Panda Bond by year-end: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

He added that Pakistan had re-entered commercial markets after two and a half years, securing financing from Middle Eastern banks and planning to issue its first Panda bond before year-end. "We even repaid a \$500 million Eurobond last month without market concern, which shows growing confidence," he said, adding that Pakistan was well-positioned to repay another \$1.3 billion due in April next year. Aurangzeb said the government had revived the stalled privatisation process. "This year, we completed the first transaction, a small bank purchased by a UAE-based conglomerate that will expand and digitise its operations," he said. The government is also confident the national airline will be privatised before the fiscal year ends.

US may cut India tariff to 15pc-16pc: (Economy: Negative)

India and the United States are nearing a long-stalled trade agreement that would reduce US tariffs on Indian imports to 15 percent to 16 percent from 50 percent, India's Mint reported on Wednesday citing three people aware of the matter. The deal, which hinges on energy and agriculture, may see India gradually scale back its imports of Russian crude oil, Mint reported.

Oil prices climb on hopes of U.S.-India trade breakthrough: (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices extended gains on Wednesday, climbing for a second straight session, as optimism grew over a potential trade agreement between the United States and India that could reshape global crude flows. Brent crude futures went up by \$0.99, or 1.61%, to \$62.31 per barrel. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures decreased by \$0.95, or 1.66%, to \$58.19 per barrel by [4:05 pm] PST.

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Pakistan, QatarEnergy to discuss LNG supply cuts amid weaker demand: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Pakistan and QatarEnergy are planning key talks for next week as Pakistan seeks to scale back liquefied natural gas (LNG) imports for next year amid weakening domestic demand, as Bloomberg reported. QatarEnergy is scheduled to meet representatives from Pakistan State Oil (PSO) on Monday and Tuesday to review request to delay or resell around two dozen LNG cargoes on the international market. While the meeting is part of regular planning for next year's supply, traders are closely watching the outcome given the size of the reduction Pakistan is proposing.

Rs180b cess demand jolts oil industry: (Economy: Negative) (OMCs: Negative)

The oil crisis in the country may deepen as the industry faces possible collapse due to claims of Rs180 billion on account of the Sindh Infrastructure Development Cess (SIDC) imposed by the Sindh government on petroleum product imports. The Sindh government on Tuesday released one oil cargo of Pakistan State Oil (PSO) that had been stuck at port over the SIDC issue. Now, the provincial government is seeking guarantees from PSO and other oil marketing companies (OMCs) of infrastructure cess payment for the release of further oil cargoes. The Sindh government and the oil industry have been locked in a dispute over the imposition of SIDC since 2021.

Sindh to procure 1.2MT of wheat at Rs3,500/maund: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Sindh Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah announced wheat at a support price of Rs3,500 per maund and disclosed his government's plan to procure between 800,000 and 1.2 million tonnes of wheat during crop 2025-26. The initiative, coupled with Rs55 billion relief package, includes substantial fertiliser subsidies (DAP and urea) to offset rising cultivation costs and support local farmers' incomes.

Pakistan, Qatar to deepen agri-cooperation: (Economy: Positive)

Federal Minister for National Food Security and Research Rana Tanveer Hussain held a meeting with the Ambassador of Qatar to Pakistan, Ali bin Mubarak Al Khater, on Wednesday to explore ways to strengthen agricultural cooperation and turn bilateral relations into deeper economic partnerships. The minister proposed creating a Joint Working Group on Agriculture to structure cooperation and identify priority projects.

Govt plans Green Maritime Corridor to revive steel mills: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Ministry of Maritime Affairs has unveiled a \$13 billion savings plan, designed to revive Pakistan Steel Mills (PSM) by establishing Pakistan's first "Sea-to-Steel Green Maritime Industrial Corridor" at Port Qasim. Pakistan currently imports around \$6 billion worth of steel annually, with demand expected to grow nearly 6% each year through 2035, according to a World Bank report. The minister noted that the proposed project could reduce steel imports by up to 20%, potentially saving over \$13 billion for the country in the next decade.

IGI Holdings eyes complete acquisition of Akzo Nobel Pakistan: (Economy: Neutral) (IGIHL: Positive)

IGI Investments (Private) Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of IGI Holdings Limited, has received in-principle board approval to acquire up to 100% of Akzo Nobel Pakistan Limited's shares, according to a disclosure filed with the Pakistan Stock Exchange. The proposed transaction involves purchasing up to 98.3% shareholding from ICI Omicron B.V., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Netherlands-based Akzo Nobel NV, and up to 1.7% from minority shareholders of the target company. Akzo Nobel Pakistan Limited, an unlisted public company, is primarily engaged in manufacturing and selling paints and coatings in the Pakistani market.
