

**Pakistan in the limelight as US, Iran 'open backchannel':** (Economy: Positive)

On the 24th day of the US-Israel war against Iran, Pakistan took centre stage in a coordinated diplomatic push alongside Turkiye and Egypt, as the trio appeared instrumental in securing a five-day pause of US plans to strike Iranian energy and power infrastructure, officials said, describing the effort as going beyond routine crisis management. "Turkiye, Egypt and Pakistan are moving beyond rhetoric, proving that while many issue statements, these countries are walking the talk to bridge the gap between Washington and Tehran," the source said. "Pakistan is reaffirming its role as a 'net regional stabiliser', leveraging its unique diplomatic position to shift the focus from confrontation toward meaningful dialogue," the source said. The scope of the backchannel discussions went beyond an immediate pause. Officials said the exchanges focused on de-escalation, reopening of the Strait of Hormuz, and the parameters of a broader end to the war.

**Trump says 'very good chance' of deal with Iran to settle current conflict:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

President Donald Trump on Monday said there was a "very good chance" that the United States could secure a deal with Iran to bring an end to the current war between the two countries that has gone on to involve the wider Middle East and jolted global supply lines. "With Iran, we've been negotiating for a long time, and this time, they mean business," Trump said. "They want to settle and we're going to get it done." He said preliminary conversations between the US and Iran had been "very, very good". "Now, Iran has one more opportunity to end its threats to America and our allies, and we hope they take it," Trump said. "We're giving it five days, and then we're going to see where that takes us. And I would say at the end of this period, I think it could very well end up being a very good deal for everybody." However, Iran's Parliamentary Speaker Mohammad Baqer Qalibaf posted on social media that no talks had been held with the US.

**Oil prices plunge 8% on US-Iran talks to resolve hostilities in the Middle East:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Oil prices dropped about 8% on Monday after United States President Donald Trump said he would postpone any military strikes against Iranian power plants for five days and cited constructive talks to resolve hostilities in the Middle East, hours before a deadline that threatened to escalate the four-week-old war. Brent futures fell \$8.92, or 8.0%, to \$103.27 a barrel at 12:31pm EDT (1631 GMT), while US West Texas Intermediate lost \$7.17, or 7.3%, to \$91.06.

**PM Shehbaz bans high-octane fuel in govt vehicles as levy jumps to Rs305:** (Economy: Negative)

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif has banned the use of high-octane fuel in all government vehicles, with the decision taking effect immediately. The ban comes with the decision to increase the petroleum levy on high-octane fuel. Under a notification issued for this purpose, the levy on high-octane has been raised by Rs200 per litre to Rs305.37 per litre, pushing the new price of High Octane Blending Component (HOBC) in the country to Rs535. The decision to increase the levy from Rs100 to Rs300 per litre was taken in a meeting chaired by the prime minister. Under the new ban, if the use of high-octane fuel in any government department's vehicle is unavoidable, the user may do so at their own personal expense. A strict ban has been imposed on its use at government expense.

**Outflow of profits rises, FDI plunges:** (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan continued paying profits and dividends on foreign investments despite the war in the region, while profit outflows increased by 10.5 percent in the first eight months of the current fiscal year (FY26). The government's performance on the external front has been satisfactory, sending abroad \$1.726 billion as profits on foreign investments during July-February FY26, an increase of \$164 million or 10.5 percent. Foreign investments have drastically fallen during FY26. The FDI during July-February fell by 33.3pc, or \$598 million, to \$1.195bn.

**SBP reserves have increased for the 32nd consecutive week:** (Economy: Positive)

The foreign exchange reserves held by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) increased by \$12.6 million or 0.08% WoW to \$16.35 billion during the week ended on March 13, 2026, data released by State Bank of Pakistan. Similarly, the country's total reserves increased by \$105.9m or 0.49% WoW to \$21.7bn. The reserves held by commercial banks rose by \$93.3m or 1.77% WoW to \$5.35bn. In the current fiscal year, SBP-held reserves have increased by \$1.85bn or 12.77%. Meanwhile, the current calendar year has seen an increase of \$298m or 1.86%.

**Pakistan's digital payments hit 3bn transactions in Q2 FY26:** (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan's payment ecosystem recorded 3.4bn retail transactions worth Rs167 trillion during the second quarter of Fiscal Year 2025–26 (October to December 2025), according to the latest Payment Systems Quarterly Review published by the SBP. The figures represent an 8% quarter-on-quarter increase in transaction volume and a 7% rise in value, emphasizing the country's accelerating shift toward digital financial services. Of the 3.4bn retail transactions recorded in Q2 FY26, 3.1bn or 92% were conducted through digital payment channels. This marks a significant improvement from 88% recorded in the same quarter last year (Q2 FY25). Digital channels include mobile banking apps, internet banking portals, ATMs, point-of-sale (POS) terminals, e-commerce platforms, and call/IVR banking services. The total value of digital payments reached Rs64tr during the quarter, up 14% from Rs56tr in the previous quarter.

**Export Facilitation Scheme utilisation period extended to 18 months:** (Economy: Positive)

The government has extended the utilisation period from nine months to 18 months to allow exporters more time to use imported zero-duty, tax-free inputs under the Export Facilitation Scheme (EFS), thereby easing cost pressures and supporting export growth. The longer timeframe is expected to reduce financial strain on exporters, particularly small and medium enterprises, which often face working capital constraints and production cycle delays, he added.

Mari Energies Limited (PSX: MARI) achieves significant hydrocarbon discovery at Shams-1 exploratory well in Mari D&PL, District Ghotki, Sindh Province. Spud in on January 30, 2026, Shams-1 reached a total depth of 3,075 meters targeting Lower Goru-B sands. The well tested a flow rate of 47.98 MMSCFD of gas with 64 barrels per day of condensate at a choke size of 64/64".

**CCP approves merger of Cyan, DH Partners into DLL:** (Economy: Positive) (DLL: Positive)

The Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP) has approved the merger of Cyan Limited and DH Partners Limited into Dawood Lawrencepur Limited, as part of an internal restructuring within the Dawood Group. According to a press release issued, the merger will be carried out under a Scheme of Amalgamation dated December 16, 2025. Under this arrangement, all assets, liabilities, and obligations of Cyan Limited and DH Partners Limited will be consolidated into Dawood Lawrencepur Limited (DLL), with shares of DLL issued to the shareholders of the merging entities. Dawood Lawrencepur Limited, a publicly listed subsidiary of Dawood Corporation, primarily manages investments in renewable energy, including wind and solar projects, along with maintaining a diversified portfolio in local capital markets. Cyan Limited is also a listed investment company focused on high-growth equity investments, while DH Partners Limited operates as an investment management firm and was listed on the Pakistan Stock Exchange in early 2025.
