

Oil prices drop on prospect of Middle East ceasefire easing supply disruption: (Economy: Positive)

Oil prices dropped more than 5% on Wednesday on the prospect of a possible ceasefire easing supply disruptions from the key Middle East producing region after reports the U.S. sent Iran a 15-point plan to end the war between them. Brent crude futures fell \$6.21, or 5.9%, to \$98.28 a barrel by 0058 GMT, after declining to as low as \$97.57. U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures were down \$4.67, or 5.1%, at \$87.68 a barrel, after falling to as low as \$86.72.

PM Shehbaz says Pakistan ready to host US-Iran talks as FO acknowledges role in de-escalation efforts: (Economy: Neutral)

In a potentially game-changing diplomatic signal, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Tuesday publicly offered Pakistan as a venue for US-Iran peace talks, an offer that received an extraordinary boost when President Donald Trump reposted it on his Truth Social platform, a move widely seen in Islamabad as Washington's tacit endorsement of Pakistan's emerging role as a mediator. In a post on X, the premier said: "Pakistan welcomes and fully supports ongoing efforts to pursue dialogue to end the war in Middle East, in the interest of peace and stability in region and beyond. Subject to concurrence by the US and Iran, Pakistan stands ready and honoured to be the host to facilitate meaningful and conclusive talks for a comprehensive settlement of the ongoing conflict."

Finance ministry says Pakistan has 'largely secured' petrol cargoes for March and April: (Economy: Neutral)

The Committee to Monitor Petrol Prices was informed on Tuesday that the country has largely secured petrol cargoes for March and April, with additional shipments planned to further strengthen supply buffers. Earlier this month, the government sharply increased diesel and petrol prices by Rs55 per litre, or 20%, citing disruptions in global supply chains caused by the ongoing US-Israel and Iran war, which pushed crude oil prices to a two-year high. Following the increase, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif constituted a monitoring committee to oversee the prices and movement of petroleum products after global oil supply lines were disrupted due to the closure of the Strait of Hormuz amid the Middle East conflict. Members were informed that overall inventories remained at comfortable levels, supported by secured import arrangements and ongoing production. Supply lines from import terminals to refineries, storage installations and retail outlets were reported to be operating in a stable and orderly manner, ensuring continuity of supply across the country.

Ogra moves towards digital fuel tracking system as ME war disrupts markets: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) held a training session for industry stakeholders on a digital track-and-trace system for petroleum products, an official statement said on Tuesday, as the country moves to tighten oversight of its fuel supply chain amid market disruptions caused by the ongoing war in Iran, reports Arab News. The oil regulator, in collaboration with the Punjab Information Technology Board (PITB), conducted an industry-wide session in Islamabad to introduce the platform, which aims to digitize monitoring across imports, production, storage and retail distribution. The initiative comes as Pakistan grapples with rising global oil prices following last month's strikes by the United States and Israel on Iran, which triggered retaliatory attacks across the Gulf, disrupted shipping routes and pushed up energy costs.

IMF blocks move to control SOE chiefs: (Economy: Neutral)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) did not accept a request to empower the government to appoint heads of the state-owned entities (SOEs) by withdrawing this authority from their boards, blocking a move that could have again strengthened the grip of the executive on these companies. The global lender also did not agree to another suggestion that the ex-officio members of the SOEs should be appointed from outside the relevant ministries, according to officials privy to the discussions held recently. Government sources told The Express Tribune that the proposals were made during the recent inconclusive talks for the \$1 billion loan tranche of the Extended Fund Facility (EFF). They said that the issue about the appointment of the chief executive officers (CEOs) had also been raised during the second review talks, but the IMF did not agree.

NEPRA okays competitive bidding for power supply: (Economy: Neutral)

The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) has approved the country's first-ever wheeling auction process, clearing the way for competitive electricity trading and declaring January 22, 2026, as the official start of commercial market operations. According to a statement issued by the regulator on Tuesday, the decision endorses the auction mechanism submitted by the Independent System and Market Operator (ISMO), allowing allocation of up to 800 megawatts of electricity through competitive bidding while ensuring recovery of stranded costs tied to market liberalisation. The approval follows federal policy changes and the issuance of Framework Guidelines for Wheeling Auctions in January 2026. NEPRA said the process, shaped through stakeholder consultation, aligns with principles of transparency, non-discrimination and procedural fairness as Pakistan transitions toward a competitive electricity market.

OGDCL commences oil production from development well in Hyderabad: (Economy: Neutral to Positive) (OGDC: Positive)

The Oil and Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL) on Tuesday announced the successful commencement of oil production from its development well Pasakhi-13 in Hyderabad, marking Pakistan's first successful horizontal oil well in a clastic reservoir. According to a statement by the company, Pasakhi-13 is currently producing 460 barrels of oil per day (BPD). The well was drilled to a measured depth of 2,966 metres, including a 546-meter horizontal section, the company said in a statement. Advanced geo-steering technology-enabled precise navigation within a narrow 3 metre drilling window, ensuring optimal placement within the reservoir's sweet spot, it added. It stated that the well was completed and tested using a short-string electric submersible pump (ESP), specifically optimised for horizontal well configurations.
