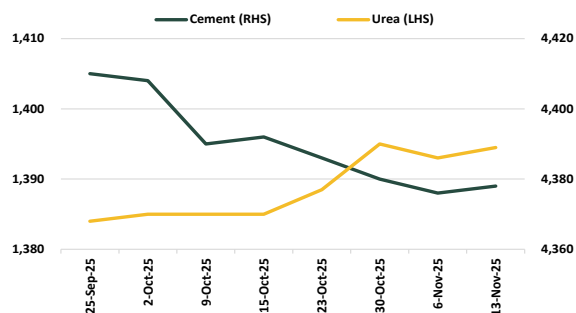

0.25pc EDS on exports scrapped: (Economy: Positive)

In a major development, the government has decided to withdraw the 0.25 percent Export Development Surcharge (EDS) on exports with immediate effect, providing long-awaited relief to exporters and improving Pakistan's competitiveness in global markets. The decision was taken at meeting presided over by Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif which was also attended by the experts.

Ogra green-lights up to 7.14% gas tariff hike after signalling 8% cut: (Economy: Negative)

In an unexpected shift, the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) approved an increase of up to 7.14% in gas prices for the current fiscal year, dismissing an earlier notification that had indicated an 8% reduction. Ogra's spokesperson, in a new statement, said the authority has approved a 7.14% revision in Sui Southern Gas Company's (SSGC) tariff and a 4.89% adjustment for Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL). For SSGC, the change translates into an addition of Rs 118.47 per mmBtu, while SNGPL's rate goes up by Rs 86.30 per mmBtu. With this decision, SSGC's price now stands at Rs 1,777.02 per mmBtu and SNGPL's at Rs 1,852.80. In the previous shortfall, Ogra allowed Rs 60.88 billion adjustment for gas companies, the spokesperson added. Meanwhile, Ogra has requested the federal government for advice on category-wise sale prices, saying that any revision, as advised by the government, will be notified regarding the same. Till such time, the existing category-wise natural gas sale prices will continue to prevail.

Ogra approves Rs6.1bn for new domestic gas connections: (Economy: Positive)

The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) approved an upfront amount of around Rs 6.1 billion for the current financial year for the Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL) and Sui Southern Gas Company (SSGC) for the provision of new RLNG-based domestic gas connections. The SNGPL had projected Rs 262 million for service lines of domestic RLNG consumers under the distribution main and Rs 393 million under measuring and regulating for 30,000 RLNG connections, which was allowed in principle by the authority. The petitioner (SNGPL), in view of an uplifting of the moratorium, has included Rs 6.5 billion in its instant petition for 300,000 domestic RLNG connections. The authority, however, allowed an upfront amount of Rs 4.3 billion. An amount of Rs 1.8 billion was approved against a request by the SSGC for domestic gas consumers for the provision of new RLNG connections. As per the government's directives, the gas utility has planned to provide approximately 50,000 new gas connections to domestic customers on RLNG in Fiscal Year 2025-26. The estimated cost for the connections would be Rs 1.8 billion.

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Pakistan proposes formal maritime cooperation framework to Bangladesh: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan has proposed a formal cooperation framework with Bangladesh to deepen bilateral maritime collaboration, including joint shipping services, port facilitation, and coordinated engagement at global maritime forums. The minister conveyed greetings from Pakistan and sought Bangladesh's support for Pakistan in the IMO Category C elections, assuring reciprocal support for Bangladesh. The proposed framework envisions joint container and bulk shipping operations between PNSC and BSC, technical training initiatives, cooperation on maritime safety, seafarer development, and mutual facilitation for port calls. Reiterating Pakistan's earlier offer, the minister highlighted the availability of Karachi Port Trust (KPT) facilities for Bangladeshi cargo, noting the port's expanding capacity and modernization efforts.

Govt urged to avert growing exit of multinationals: (Economy: Positive)

The federal government urgently needs to introduce an investment and business protection policy including a rational tax regime for the MNCs to stop their exit from Pakistan and to control a looming economic threat to the country. The primary objective must be to change the high import tariff protection policy to an export-oriented strategy for the MNCs. "In a major development, the government is considering Federal Excise Duty as an unfriendly tax for the multinational companies operating in Pakistan. The multiplicity of indirect taxes would be ended for the highest taxpaying and compliant MNCs to provide a level playing field." Presently, over 200 multinational companies play a vital role in driving commerce and industry and contribute more than one-third of the Federal Board of Revenue's (FBR) total tax collection.

PPL executes successful workover operations in Adam West X-1 ST well: (Economy: Positive) (PPL: Positive)

Pakistan Petroleum Limited has executed successful workover operations at the Adam West X-1 ST well in the Hala Block, located in Matiari district, Sindh Province. The company operates the block with a 65% working interest alongside joint venture partner Mari Energies Limited (35% WI). The Adam West X-1 well initially discovered hydrocarbons in the Lower Goru formation in September 2014. After commencing production in June 2015, the well encountered complications in 2019 when water breakthrough led to a complete cessation of gas flow. Multiple attempts to isolate the lower water-producing intervals proved unsuccessful. Reservoir modeling confirmed the viability of drilling a sidetrack using rig equipment. The workover operation began in October 2025, with the primary target to drill a sidetrack and complete the well above the water-producing zones. Following the successful workover, the Adam West X-1 ST well is now producing at approximately 8.5 MMscfd at wellhead pressure of 540 psig and choke size of 58/64".

Premium Textile moves ahead with 7.5MW wind power plan: (Economy: Positive) (PRET: Positive)

Premium Textile Mills Limited (PSX: PRET) has approved the purchase and installation of a 7.5-megawatt wind turbine, marking a significant step toward expanding the company's renewable energy footprint. The approval was granted through a circular resolution on November 24, 2025. The project carries an estimated cost of \$ 4.15 million. The company stated that this investment aligns with its ongoing commitment to sustainable and environmentally responsible business practices.
