Indices	Current	Previous	Change	Green hydrogen plant to be built in Sindh: Pakistan's first green hydrogen plant will be built in Sindh with a capacity to produce approximately 150,000kg fuel per day, it emerged on Saturday. A memorandum of understanding (MoU) was signed by the Chief Executive Officer of UK-listed Oracle Power Public Ltd, Naheed Memon, and Chief Representative in Pakistan of Power China International for development of the first green hydrogen project in the country. Informed sources said that the MoU signing ceremony of 400MW project, held at the provincial energy department, was witnessed by Energy Minister Imtiaz Ahmed Shaikh and Consul General of China in Karachi Li Bijian. They said that the announced facility would produce approximately 150,000 kg per day of green hydrogen from a 400MW capacity plant using energy from wind and solar farms.			
KSE100 Index	45,578.36	45,821.40	(243.04)	SBP allows dollar buying with e-Sahulat verification: For facilitating genuine buyers, the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) on Saturday temporarily allowed the exchange companies to sell over \$500 to individuals on production of biometric certification from the National Database and Registration Authority's e-Sahulat outlets. The SBP had directed the exchange companies through a circular dated Oct 7 to conduct mandatory biometric verification from Oct 22 for all foreign currency sale transactions equivalent to \$500 and above and outward remittances. However, the biometric verification requirement could not be implemented since the system to connect with Nadra was not available. The central bank took this decision to stop dollar outflow particularly to Afghanistan following a sharp increase in demand which destabilised the exchange rate in the open market amid media reports that millions of dollars were being smuggled out to Kabul particularly after the change of regime.			
All Shares Index	31,144.25	31,279.32	(135.07)	Private sector likely to be allowed LNG imports: The private sector is likely to be allowed to import Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) from next month, the All Pakistan CNG Association (APCNGA) said on Saturday. "During a recent meeting, Energy Minister Hammad Azhar was persuaded to allow the private parties including the CNG sector to import LNG on their own in a bid to meet the demand and overcome the shortage that mostly emerges in winter," APCNGA chairman Ghyas Paracha told Dawn. Public and private stakeholders were unanimous in the meeting to accord permission in this regard since most issues on the part of state-owned gas utilities and other entities have been resolved, the APCNGA office-bearer said.

China has already sought compensation of \$ 38 million from Pakistan for the killed and injured Chinese engineers working on Dasu project prior to resuming work on the stalled project. "Most of the concerns of Chinese company including security have been addressed. However, negotiation on compensation package is still under discussion to make it rational," said an official on condition of anonymity. Water and Power Development Authority (Wadpa) was in talks with the Chinese company to resume work on the stalled project of 4,300 MW.			
INTERNATIONAL MARKETS				Top oil exporter Saudi Arabia targets zero carbon emissions by 2060: Top crude exporter Saudi Arabia will aim to achieve net zero carbon emissions by 2060, its de facto ruler said on Saturday, days before the COP26 global climate summit. The kingdom, one of the world's biggest polluters, said it would also join a global effort to cut methane emissions by 30 percent by 2030. The UN says more than 130 countries have set or are considering a target of reducing greenhouse gas emissions to net zero by 2050, a target it says is "imperative" to safeguard a livable climate. "I announce today Saudi Arabia's target to reach net zero emissions by 2060 through its circular carbon economy approach," said Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman in a recorded statement at the "Saudi Green Initiative" forum.

Power Div. seeks Rs134.8bn TSG to clear IPPs' dues: Power Division has sought a Technical Supplementary Grant (TSG) of Rs134.783 billion to clear remaining agreed amount of 20 Independent Power Producers (IPPs) by December 3, 2021, official sources told Business Recorder. Of the 20 IPPs, M.s Hubco and Kapco belong to pre-1994 Generation Policy - six IPPs belong to 1994 Generation Policy, whereas 12 are related to wind, solar and bagasse. The Government of Pakistan (GoP) constituted a Committee for power sector audit, resolution and future roadmap in August 2019, to look into the issues faced by the power sector, including purportedly higher profits made by the IPPs, and to recommend a way forward. The Committee presented its report in March 2020, highlighting the issues faced across the power sector. In the light of the Committee's recommendations, based on the Cabinet Committee on Energy's (CCoE) decision to initiate negotiations with the IPPs, the Federal Government constituted another Committee (Negotiation Committee).

Pakistan accepts most of IMF conditionalities?: Pakistan has agreed to implement most of the conditions of the International Monetary Fund for the resuscitation of its stalled \$6 billion extended loan facility. Sources divulged on Saturday that Pakistan succumbed to the global lender pressure agreeing to implement most of the conditions, which the Fund had proposed. The IMF board will pronounce the final decision regarding the resumption of Pakistan's loan programme. After the Fund's approval, Pakistan will get \$1 billion tranche under the extended loan facility. Sources said that Pakistan agreed to raise tax collection, speed up privatization process and introduce reforms in the power sector as suggested by the international money lender. The Fund has asked the Finance Ministry to review its economic targets.

Agreement reached on debt deferral: The governments of Japan and Pakistan on Friday agreed on debt deferral amounting to US\$200 million, as the second phase of "the G20 Debt Service Suspension Initiative (DSSI)". Prior to this, both Governments agreed on the first debt deferral amounting to approx. US\$370 million on April 27, 2021 under the same initiative, said a press release issued here. The total amount of deferred debt has reached approx. US\$570 million, which will widen the fiscal space for the Government of Pakistan to restore its economy affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. The concessional loans, subject to debt deferral, have been utilized for infrastructure development such as roads, tunnels, power plants and grids, irrigation, water supply, and drainage facilities in Pakistan from the early 1990s to the mid-2010s.

SPI up 1.38pc WoW: The Sensitive Price Indicator (SPI) for the week ended October 21, 2021 recorded an increase of 1.38 percent due to increase in prices of tomatoes (41.63 percent), diesel (10.06 percent), petrol (8.19 percent), LPG (7.11 percent), mustard oil (2.23 percent), vegetable ghee 1kg (1.91 percent), bread plain (1.84 percent), potatoes (1.57 percent), and cooking oil 5-liter (1.50 percent), says the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS). The year-on-year trend depicts increase of 14.48 percent.

Goods of Afghan, Iran origins: FBR to set up 'LVC' for value determination: The Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) has decided to constitute a Local Valuation Committee (LVC) for determination of value of goods of Afghan and Iran origin to regulate the Pak-Afghan/Iran bilateral trade. The FBR has issued SRO1352(I)/2021 to amend the Customs Rules, 2021, here on Friday. According to the draft rules, the new rules shall be applicable for the determination of value of goods of Afghan and Iran origin by discouraging the incidences of underinvoicing and smuggling. The new customs values shall be applicable to the goods, which are imported through land route from Iran and Afghanistan.

SBP releases PSR: PRISM records 60pc growth in FY21: Digital payments adoption continues its journey on upward trajectory and large-value payments segment, known as Real-time Inter-Bank Settlement Mechanism (PRISM), recorded a growth of 60 percent in FY21. The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) on Friday released its annual Payment Systems Review (PSR) for the fiscal year 2020-21, which shows strong growth in the space of digital financial transactions in the country. According to PSR, the SBP continued its pursuit for the development of a robust and efficient payments ecosystem in Pakistan and this transformation was further fueled by an unprecedented pandemic raging its way throughout the world coupled with a supportive regulatory environment, which resulted in a sustained momentum of growth across all the key areas of the payments ecosystem. The PSR revealed that transactions processed through PRISM, recorded YoY growth of 60 percent by number of transactions volume and 12.8 percent by value.

Express Tribune:

SSGC board set to approve purchase of PSM land: The board of directors of Sui Southern Gas Company (SSGC) is set to approve the acquisition of a piece of land of Pakistan Steel Mills (PSM) on lease to build a tie-in point for two new LNG terminals. Sources told The Express Tribune that SSGC was initially reluctant to acquire the land for establishing the tie-in point, however, the company agreed after intervention from Petroleum Division Secretary Dr Arshad Mahmood. Now, it has acquired nearly 17 acres of land from PSM on lease. The LNG terminals are being set up by private parties. The Petroleum Division had informed the Cabinet Committee on Energy (CCOE) in a meeting that the issue of tie-in point had been resolved and land was acquired by SSGC on lease from PSM. Officials said that the SSGC board was likely to discuss the matter in its upcoming meeting and approve the deal.

IMF seeks closure of public entities' accounts in banks: The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has placed a condition on Pakistan to close all the bank accounts maintained by public sector entities and the defence ministry in commercial banks. The money should be transferred to the central bank's account. The demand is aimed at bringing back hundreds of billions of rupees under the government's control that are currently placed with the commercial banks in violation of various instructions by the finance ministry. Sources told The Express Tribune that one of the reasons behind a delay in reaching a staff-level agreement was the IMF's insistence to roll out the treasury single account-II system within this fiscal year. The global lender also wanted that instead of promulgating a presidential ordinance, the government should introduce a finance bill in parliament to withdraw tax exemptions and slap more taxes.
