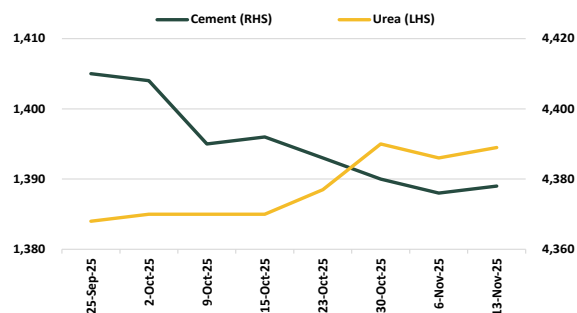

SIFC unveils business-friendly roadmap: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC) National Coordinator Lt General Sarfraz Ahmad on Thursday laid out a roadmap to make the economy competitive by substantially reducing the corporate tax burden, cutting down interest rate and having a pragmatic exchange rate. He said that the government was seriously looking at reducing taxes on the corporate sector and taxes like super tax, which was an ad hoc arrangement, should be removed. Ahmad said that there was also a need to reduce 29% corporate income tax to 25% and the inter-corporate income tax must be eliminated. After adding all taxes, the effective corporate income tax rate is over 50%, which is not sustainable, he added.

Pakistan fuel oil exports scale fresh high in 2025, to hold in 2026: (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan's annual fuel oil exports hit an all-time high this year and are expected to trend steady to higher next year, as higher domestic taxes deterred purchases while power plants are switching to cleaner alternatives. Exports so far this year have breached 1.4 million metric tons (about 8.9 million barrels), up over 16% from the full-year volume in 2024, the data from Kpler showed, with most of these exports ending up in Southeast Asia and the Middle East. The leading Pakistan fuel oil exporter was Pak-Arab Refinery, according to traders, while other exporters included Cnergyico, Attock Refinery, National Refinery and Pakistan Refinery.

Oct industrial power consumption jumps 20pc YoY: CPPA-G: (Economy: Positive)

The Central Power Purchasing Agency–Guaranteed (CPPA-G) has revealed that industrial electricity consumption increased by 20 percent in October 2025 compared to the corresponding month of 2024. The CPPA-G proposed a negative adjustment of 65 paise per kWh for October 2025. However, since it will replace the negative adjustment of 48 paise per kWh for September 2025, the net impact on consumers—excluding lifeline consumers—will be 17 paise per kWh.

Past IPP agreements lacked transparency: Leghari: (Economy: Neutral)

Federal Minister for Energy Sardar Owais Ahmad Khan Leghari said on Thursday Pakistan was rapidly increasing its share of low-cost renewable energy, while acknowledging that several power-sector agreements signed with Independent Power Producers (IPPs) in the past “were not transparent”. “We have identified 28 major reforms, and results will start becoming visible soon,” he said. He noted that the share of renewable energy in the national energy mix had already reached 55%. “The government will no longer remain the sole future buyer of electricity; direct transactions in the market will become the norm.”

SBP-held foreign exchange reserves rise by \$9 million to \$14.56bn: (Economy: Negative)

The foreign exchange reserves held by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) increased by \$9 million on a weekly basis, reaching \$14.56 billion as of November 21, 2025, data released on Thursday showed. According to the central bank, total liquid foreign reserves held by the country stood at \$19.6 billion, while net foreign reserves held by commercial banks were recorded at \$5.04 billion. Last week, the SBP's reserves had posted a modest rise as well, continuing a trend of gradual accumulation.

Sindh approves plan for 600 EV charging stations: (Economy: Positive, Auto: Positive)

The Sindh government has formally approved the strategic partnership submitted by ADM Group China to establish more than 600 electric vehicle (EV) charging stations across the province, marking a major step towards clean mobility and sustainable infrastructure development. The approval was granted by Minister Syed Nasir Hussain Shah. The minister not only approved the initiative but also directed that the proposal be forwarded to Special Secretary for immediate processing, identification of suitable locations and commencement of implementation.

HSD imports rise on harvesting demand, economic uptick: (Economy: Neutral to Negative)

Pakistan imported 0.43 million metric tonnes (MTs) of high speed diesel (HSD) in the first four months of the current financial year after its demand surged during this period. According to oil industry data, HSD imports rose on the back of an uptick in economic activity as well as the harvesting season for Rabi crops in the country. HSD consumption increased significantly in October due to the harvesting season. Oil sales data showed HSD consumption grew 21 per cent in October compared to September this fiscal year. Cumulatively, HSD sales surged by 11 per cent in the first four months of the current fiscal year over the same period of the last fiscal year.

Pakistan textile giant plans major expansion in renewable energy, yarn, and dairy: (Economy: Positive, NML: Positive)

Nishat Mills Limited (NML), the flagship company of Nishat Group, is pursuing a multi-pronged expansion strategy with plans to add 4 megawatts (MW) of solar capacity, expand yarn production and invest up to Rs5 billion in Nishat Sutas Dairy Limited. With 38MW of solar already installed, plans are underway for an additional 4MW installation, alongside proposed investments in a 45TP steam boiler and battery-storage infrastructure. The company also plans to expand its open-end yarn capacity by adding 3,000 rotors, taking the total to 13,000.

SNGPL reports second-highest annual profit: (Economy: Positive, SNGPL: Positive)

Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Ltd reported the second-highest profit in its history for FY 2024-25, according to disclosures at its 61st annual general meeting held on Thursday in Lahore. SNGPL posted a profit before tax of Rs24,446 million and a profit after tax of Rs14,592 million, translating into earnings per share of Rs23.01. On the board's recommendation, shareholders cleared a final cash dividend of Rs3 per share, or 30 per cent, for the fiscal year.
