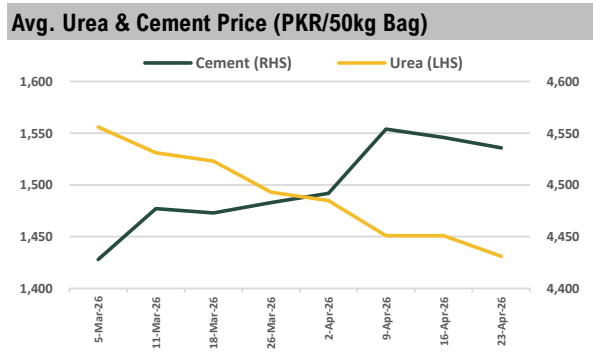

**UAE leaves OPEC and OPEC+ in huge blow to global oil producers' group** (Economy: Negative)

The United Arab Emirates said on Tuesday it quit OPEC and OPEC+, dealing a heavy blow to the oil exporting groups and their de facto leader, Saudi Arabia, at a time when the Iran war has caused a historic energy shock and unsettled the global economy. The stunning loss of the UAE, a longstanding OPEC member, could create disarray and weaken the group, which has usually sought to show a united front despite internal disagreements over a range of issues from geopolitics to production quotas. But the UAE exit from OPEC represents a big win for U.S. President Donald Trump, who has accused the organisation of "ripping off the rest of the world" by inflating oil prices. Trump has also linked U.S. military support for the Gulf with oil prices, saying that while the U.S. defends OPEC members they "exploit this by imposing high oil prices". The move came after the UAE, a regional business hub and one of Washington's most important allies, criticised fellow Arab states for not doing enough to protect it from numerous Iranian attacks during the war.

**Energy prices expected to surge 24pc, reaching highest level since 2022 Russia-Ukraine war: World Bank assessment:** (Economy: Negative)

Energy prices are projected to surge by 24 per cent this year to their highest level since Russia's invasion of Ukraine in 2022, as the war in the Middle East sends a severe shock through global commodity markets, the World Bank Group said in its latest Commodity Markets Outlook. Overall, commodity prices are forecast to rise 16pc in 2026, driven by soaring energy and fertiliser prices and record-high prices for several key metals, according to the assessment. "The shock will have serious implications for job creation and development," the analysis indicates. The World Bank noted: "Attacks on energy infrastructure and shipping disruptions in the Strait of Hormuz, which handles about 35pc of global seaborne crude oil trade, have triggered the largest oil supply shock on record, with an initial reduction in global oil supply of about 10 million barrels per day."

**Trump says Iran wants US to open Hormuz Strait as soon as possible:** (Economy: Positive)

President Donald Trump said on Tuesday that Iran has said it was in a state of collapse and wants the United States to open the Strait of Hormuz as quickly as possible. It was not clear from Trump's social media post how Iran had communicated that message. "Iran has just informed us that they are in a 'State of Collapse.' They want us to 'Open the Hormuz Strait,' as soon as possible, as they try to figure out their leadership situation (Which I believe they will be able to do!)" Trump said in a social media post. The White House did not immediately return a request for comment on the Truth Social post. Trump is unhappy with the latest Iranian proposal on resolving the two-month war, a US official told Reuters, dampening hopes for a resolution of the conflict that has disrupted energy supplies, fueled inflation and killed thousands of people.

**Oil rises on reports US will extend Iran blockade, prolonging Mideast supply disruptions:** (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices rose on Wednesday, extending a multi-day rally, on reports the US will extend its blockade of Iranian ports, likely prolonging supply disruptions from the key Middle East producing region. US President Donald Trump has instructed aides to prepare for an extended blockade of Iran, the Wall Street Journal reported late on Tuesday, citing US officials. Trump will opt to continue to squeeze Iran's economy and oil exports by preventing shipping to and from its ports, the report said. Brent crude futures for June rose 52 cents, or 0.47%, to \$111.78 a barrel at 0154 GMT, climbing for an eighth day. The June contract expires on Thursday and the more active July contract was at \$104.84, up 0.4%. US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) futures for June rose 57 cents, or 0.57%, to \$100.50 a barrel after gaining 3.7% in the previous session, climbing for seven out of the last eight days.

**IMF's Executive Board to discuss Pakistan on May 8:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) included Pakistan on its Executive Board agenda on May 08, 2026, according to its updated website. The Executive Board is set to deliberate final approval for the release of the next \$1.21 billion tranche, covering the third review under the Extended Fund Facility (EFF) and the second review of the Resilience and Sustainability Facility (RSF). Upon approval, Pakistan will have access to about USD 1.0 billion (SDR 760 million) under the EFF and about USD 210 million (SDR 154 million) under the RSF, bringing total disbursements under the two arrangements to about USD 4.5 billion.

**EIB set to bring €160m in financing:** (Economy: Positive)

The European Investment Bank (EIB) is set to return to Pakistan after a decade, bringing €160 million in financing for housing reconstruction and water infrastructure, officials announced on Tuesday. Formal signing of the agreements will be held Wednesday (today). The announcement, made at the EU-Pakistan Business Forum, signals a revival of EIB funding in Pakistan, with €100 million earmarked for climate-resilient housing in Sindh and €60 million for improving water quality in Karachi. EIB Vice-President Nicola Beer said the bank's return reflects a renewed commitment to Pakistan's climate resilience and inclusive recovery, particularly for vulnerable communities.

**EU-Pakistan Business Network launched:** (Economy: Positive)

Pakistan and the European Union (EU) on Tuesday formally launched the EU-Pakistan Business Network, a new platform designed to shift bilateral economic engagement from dialogue to deal-making by connecting European investors with Pakistan's policy and regulatory framework. Speaking at the inaugural session of the first-ever high-level EU-Pakistan Business Forum, officials said the network would serve as a centralised platform. They said that it will enable European companies to engage more effectively with government ministries, regulators and local businesses while addressing long-standing issues of policy consistency, coordination and market access. The platform – the EU-Pakistan Business Network – is expected to boost new investment flows and strengthen existing commercial links.

**Up to 25 kW: NEPRA removes licence requirement for small solar users:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) abolished on Tuesday the licensing requirement for solar consumers with systems of up to 25 kilowatts, offering relief to households and small businesses looking to adopt renewable energy. The authority also announced it wouldn't charge fee from the small solar users. The development comes two days after the Power Division requested the NEPRA to abolish the application fee and eliminate the licence requirement for solar consumers with systems of 25 kilowatts or less. It asked the NEPRA to revert to the 2015 framework for solar systems of 25 kW and below.

**Arif Habib consortium acquires remaining 25% stake in PIA:** (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Arif Habib consortium has acquired the remaining 25% shareholding in the Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) from the government, elevating the private sector ownership in the national carrier to 100% with an aim to increase the fleet size to 50 aircrafts by September 2026. Aqeel Karim Dhedhi, the founding chairman of AKD Group having 10.25% stake in the fully privatised airline through the consortium, said the owners had deposited the bank guarantee for the payment of Rs45 billion for the latest 25% shareholding with the government on Monday that was the last day for purchasing the remaining stake in the PIA.
