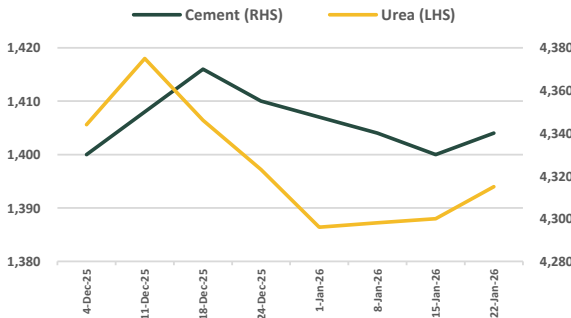

World Indices			Court upholds super tax, grants relief to oil and gas companies: (Economy: Negative) (E&P: Positive) Pakistan's Constitutional Court has delivered a final verdict on the country's super tax, bringing an end to years of legal uncertainty. Several companies had challenged the tax in different High Courts, arguing that it was unconstitutional or could not be applied to earlier tax years. The Constitutional Court rejected these arguments. Earlier High Court decisions had exempted taxpayers from paying the levy for that year, but the Constitutional Court overturned those judgments. KIBOR Rates			ECC approves TSGs of over Rs66.11bn: (Economy: Neutral to Positive) The Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) of the Cabinet on Wednesday approved several technical supplementary grants (TSGs) of over Rs66.11 billion, including Rs23.42 billion for sharing of subsidy on imported urea at a 50:50 basis between the federal government and provincial governments. Exchange Rates			ECC approves wheat offloading, sector funding: (Economy: Neutral to Positive) Pakistan's top economic decision-making body on Wednesday approved the offloading of 500,000 metric tons of government-held wheat and sanctioned more than Rs66bn in supplementary grants. The moves are aimed at easing pressure on food prices, reducing fiscal costs and keeping essential public services running. EU market: India becomes significantly more competitive: APTMA: (Economy: Negative) (Textile: Negative)

The All Pakistan Textile Mills Association (APTMA) has warned that India has become significantly more competitive in the European Union (EU) market, effectively neutralizing — and in several segments overtaking — Pakistan's existing GSP+ advantage. Former caretaker Commerce minister Gohar Ijaz said that the "zero-tariff honeymoon" for Pakistan's exports to the EU is over, as the same zero-duty access is now available to all major regional competitors. He noted that Pakistan exported approximately USD 9 billion worth of goods to the EU last year.

Pakistan offers competitive pricing to expand rice exports to Turkiye: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan is seeking to boost rice exports to Turkiye by offering globally competitive prices and increasing shipment volumes, as intense competition from rival exporters squeezes margins in international markets. Khan said Pakistan has sufficient exportable rice supplies this season but faces pricing pressure from competitors such as India and Vietnam. While export volumes remain strong, aggressive pricing by rival suppliers has weighed on global prices, he said.

Bank deposits increase to Rs37.4tr in Dec: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The total deposits held by scheduled banks have moved up by 5.8% to Rs37.43 trillion in December compared to Rs35.38tr by the end of last month. When compared to the same month of last year, banks' deposits have risen by 23.6%, compared to Rs30.28tr held in December 2024, data released by the central bank showed.
