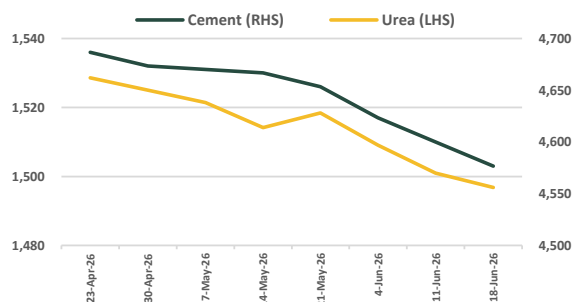

Iran and US agree to halt attacks and renew talks, Axios reports: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Iran and the United States agreed to halt recent hostilities in the Gulf and renew talks regarding their dispute over the Strait of Hormuz, Axios reported on Sunday, a move that could end tit-for-tat strikes that had threatened to unravel an interim peace agreement. The two sides plan to meet Tuesday in Qatar, Axios reported, citing a senior US official. Reuters could not immediately confirm the report. The White House did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

Oil climbs following renewed US, Iran strikes in Middle East: (Economy: Negative)

Oil prices rose on Monday following days of tit-for-tat strikes by the US and Iran that underscored the fragility of their interim peace deal and again slowed energy shipping through the Strait of Hormuz. Brent crude futures climbed 58 cents, or 0.8%, to \$72.57 a barrel at 0207 GMT while U.S. West Texas Intermediate crude was at \$70.11 a barrel, up 88 cents, or 1.3%.

Iran warns ships not to bypass its chosen Hormuz route: (Economy: Negative)

Iran's top diplomat warned Sunday that any attempt by shipping to bypass its preferred route through the Strait of Hormuz would "increase tensions" in the Middle East, as US and Iranian forces again traded attacks across the vital seaway. The exchanges underscored the fragility of a Pakistan-brokered agreement aimed at ending the war launched by the United States and Israel in February, which disrupted shipping through the strait and rattled global energy markets.

Iran and US step up attacks: (Economy: Negative)

Iran launched missiles and drones at US military sites in Kuwait and Bahrain early on Sunday, shortly after President Donald Trump threatened to wipe out the Iranian leadership if they did not stick to the interim agreement to end their war. Israel said on Sunday it had struck Iran-backed armed Hezbollah militants in Lebanon on Saturday, just a day after it agreed the latest ceasefire deal with Lebanon to calm fighting that Iran says must end if the wider agreement is to stick.

Govt eyes discounted oil as sanctions on Iran ease: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Pakistan is considering importing cheaper oil and gas from Iran after a temporary easing of US sanctions opened a narrow window for renewed energy trade with Tehran, Petroleum Minister Ali Pervaiz Malik said on Sunday. Speaking to reporters in Lahore, Mr Malik said the government was actively exploring ways to reduce energy costs and was evaluating the possibility of sourcing discounted Iranian crude. Pakistan could save an estimated \$170 million to \$340m annually if it imports 10pc to 20pc of its crude oil requirements from Iran at discounted rates, including lower freight costs.

Govt keeps petrol, diesel unchanged: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

The government kept petrol and high-speed diesel (HSD) prices unchanged, maintaining petrol at Rs299.50 per litre and HSD at Rs311.47 per litre, according to a notification issued by the Petroleum Division. The price buildup data from Euro Oil (Pvt) Limited shows the stability was achieved despite movement in underlying components.

JP Morgan cuts H2FY26 brent forecast, sees year-end price at \$78: (Economy: Neutral)

JP Morgan has lowered its Brent crude oil price forecast for the second half of 2026, pointing to weaker-than-anticipated inventory drawdowns and larger-than-expected demand losses as key drivers behind the revision. The US investment bank now sees Brent averaging \$86 per barrel in the third quarter and \$80 in the fourth, with prices projected to exit 2026 at \$78 per barrel.

Barclays raises Pakistan dollar bonds to overweight: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

Barclays Bank Plc has upgraded its rating on Pakistan's sovereign dollar bonds to overweight, reversing a downgrade it had issued in May. The bank points to a more favourable global oil market outlook as a key driver of the decision. According to Bloomberg, Pakistan's external position has shown considerable resilience that warrants a more optimistic stance.

New five-year auto policy proposes sweeping tax cuts: (Economy: Neutral to Positive)

In a major bid to rescue a stagnant automotive industry and provide relief to middle-class buyers, the government has drafted a sweeping five-year auto policy (2026–31) that features aggressive reductions in import duties and taxes. The policy also seeks to carefully rebalance the domestic manufacturing ecosystem by cutting customs duties on imported auto parts from 35 per cent to 25 per cent. While this provides immediate cost relief to domestic Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs), the warning adds to concerns among local vendor industries, who will see their protection margins significantly diminished.
